SEPTEMBER 24, 2017

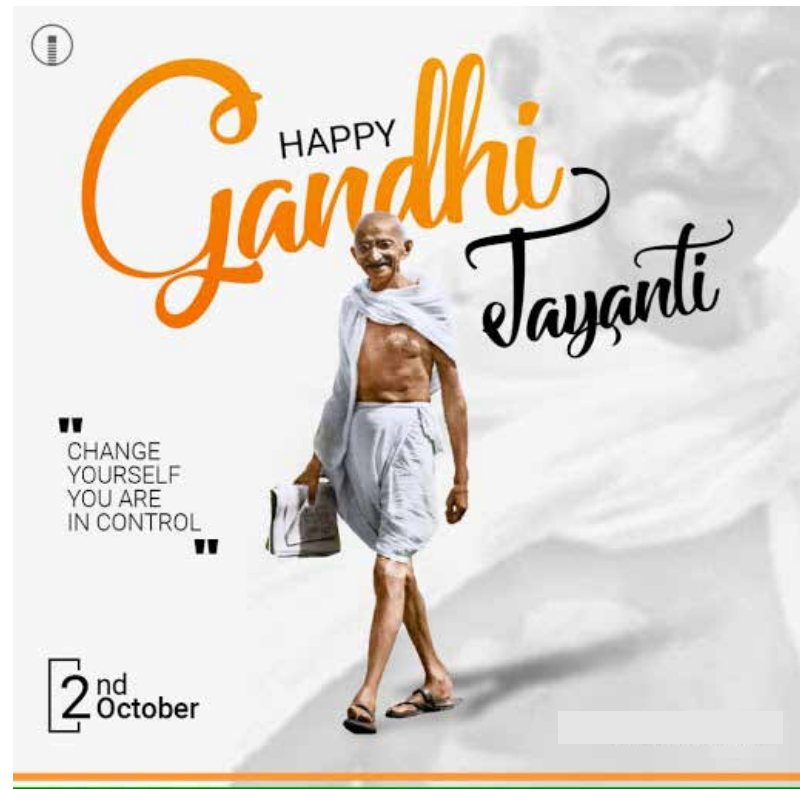
NSS Day was celebrated by the volunteers by conducting a rally to the adopted village.

FEBRUARY 06, 2018

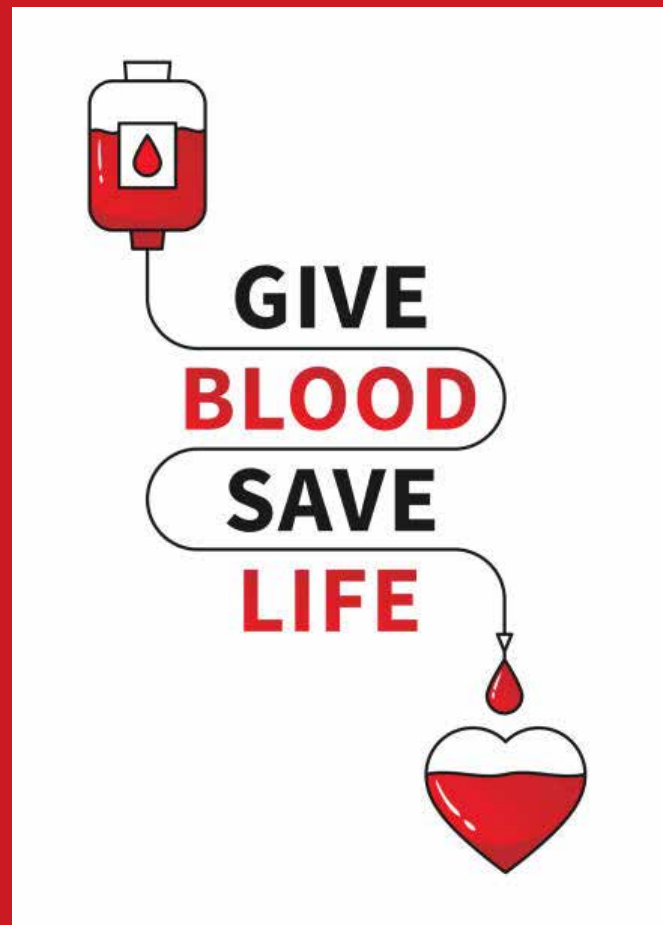
N.S.S units of SES College always took a great initiative in charity works. NSS Volunteers donated the dress that they collected from Avanakol to Ashraya at Mathamangalam
