Excellence is an art won through training and habit. This excellence is achieved through continual effort. This college attained B+ in the second cycle of the NAAC accreditation. We believe in grooming our students into becoming better citizens of tomorrow.

Staff Members

We have 26 permanent members on the teaching faculty and 08 guest lecturers working along with them. Also we have 11 members as the administrative staff in the college. Smt. Bhavya Ravindran is appointed as the librarian in the college library in the month of October 2023. We have 13708 books and 56 journals and periodicals in the library.

Staff Support Programmes

1. IQAC, SES College, Sreekandapuram in association with The Kerala State Higher Education Council has organised an Online Faculty Development Programme on Outcome Based Education. It was a National level seven day faculty development programme. It was held from 18th to 25th, January, 2023. Around 2000 faculties from various parts of the country including all 51 faculty members from SES College participated in it.

2. IQAC, SES College, Sreekandapuram in association with National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission, Govt. of India conducted an awareness programme on Intellectual Property Rights on 16th February, 2023. It was an online programme. Around 400 people attended the programme including 44 faculty members.

3. IQAC, SES College, Sreekandapuram also conducted a faculty development programme on Kerala Service Rules on 4th March, 2023. 21 teaching staff members and 13 non-teaching staff members attended it.

As part of the academic enhancement of the faculty our teachers have participated in 34 Faculty development programme, 8 members participated in Refresher Courses, 13 members participated in national and international seminars, 2 members participated in conferences and 8 members have published articles in approved journals

Computer lab

Quality education is an essential requisite in today's competitive environment. We have a well equipped computer centre in the campus where the students can achieve Computer literacy through this centre. They can also utilise the internet access through this centre. Internet connectivity has been provided to all departments, library and administrative office.

We are very happy to announce that Adv. Santhoshkumar M P has offered financial assistance in setting 20 computers for the college computer lab and paper works are in process for getting the computers as early as possible.

DIGITAL UPLIFTMENT

In the Academic year 2022-23, the recent changes in the mode of teaching has enabled us to get equipped with the modern teaching modalities. As a result we are doing our teaching by means of offline as well as Online platforms. The University has started transferring the question papers for the university examination by online means. As a flagship of our college we have conducted **International Webinar “Convergence” for teaching faculty** in which we had Resource persons and delegates also from outside India. Several webinars have been organised for our students, by all the departments of the college. We are conducting many other online activities and model examination also for our students.

PTA

We have a very responsible PTA in the campus and the response from them have been overwhelming and very initiative.. They take active interest in the overall development of the institution especially the welfare and discipline of the students. Remuneration to the guest lecturers, reading materials to the general library, Grants for conducting seminars, grants for conducting model examination, Grants for college union and fine arts, grants for conducting sports and other activities in the campus are being provided by this body. The PTA of the college takes special interest in organising counselling classes and personal counselling to students and several other student friendly programmes every year.

Student Support Programmes

The total strength of students in the campus are 730.

There are several support programmes implemented for the students. We have made MOU with many of the institutions and academic firms for exchanging and imparting knowledge to the students of the college. Many of the departments have started add on Courses and we have started value added crafts course also in the college. The objective of these courses are to provide an opportunity to do an employment oriented /skill based course to introduce careerenhancement and to have utility for job, self-employment and empowerment of the students, which ultimately helps them to better living.

Student Counselling Cell

The college Counselling cell is functioning efficiently under the supervision of Dr. Sunitha Joseph who is specialised in this area and personal care is given to each students of the college by rendering the service of psychological counselling. This year we gave personnel counselling to those who were ready for it.

Women’s Hostel

In our women’s hostel we make special efforts in providing wholesome food at minimal rate. We expect the hostel to be a place with care, comfort, warmth and ambiance to our students to make it their second home.

Endowments

We have established 45 endowments for the students who prove proficiency in studies and excellence in all curricular and extracurricular activities in the campus.

We have been conducting several seminars in the college. Various departments organise different seminars bringing eminent resource persons for enlightening the academic proficiency and prospects of the students. Depts. Organise seminar talks by experts to expose our students to new emerging ideas and concepts in their respective fields. Many of the depts. organized field trips for charity works to reach out to the less privileged sections of the society.

Co curricular activities

We have two NSS units and one NCC unit functioning efficiently in the campus. 200 are enrolled in NSS unit and 100 students enrolled as NCC cadets. Several of our students have excelled themselves and brought credit to the college in both curricular and extracurricular activities. Every year Residential Leadership Camps are conducted on the basis of the direction of the University.

This year the NSS units of the college have taken up a project of building 2 houses for the poor people in association with Chittilappally Foundation which is major project of the college

Our students have brought many laurels in the field of arts and sports

We got Re accreditation of the NAAC in second Cycle at B Plus grade (B+) under the leadership of IQAC Coordinator Dr. Sajeesh T J, and several beautifications and maintenance work were made on the campus. Our management has obtained sanction for starting a new self-financed college under Kanur University. This college is likely to be started in the coming academic year. Construction of the Administrative building is in progress with the support of RUSA fund. The renovation of the College Seminar Hall has been completed with the support of RUSA fund.
