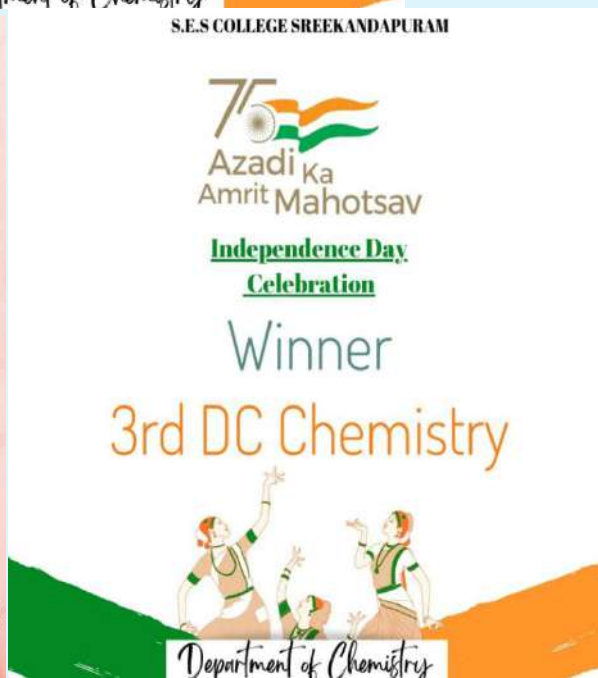
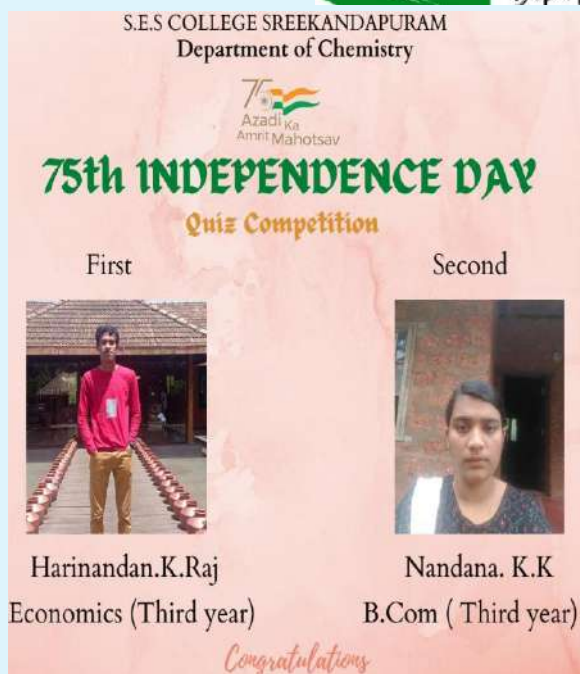

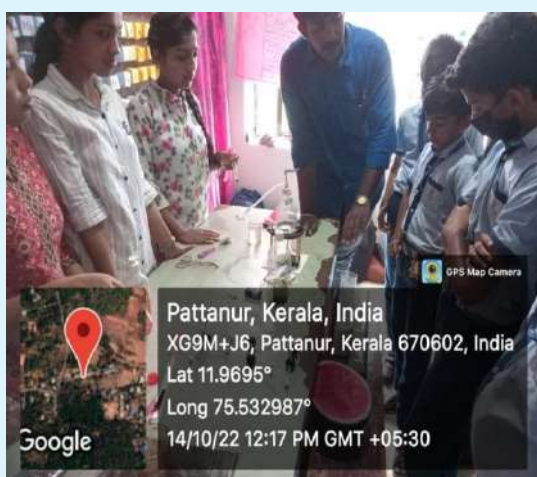
Alumni meet "Vaagamathanalil 2022-23"

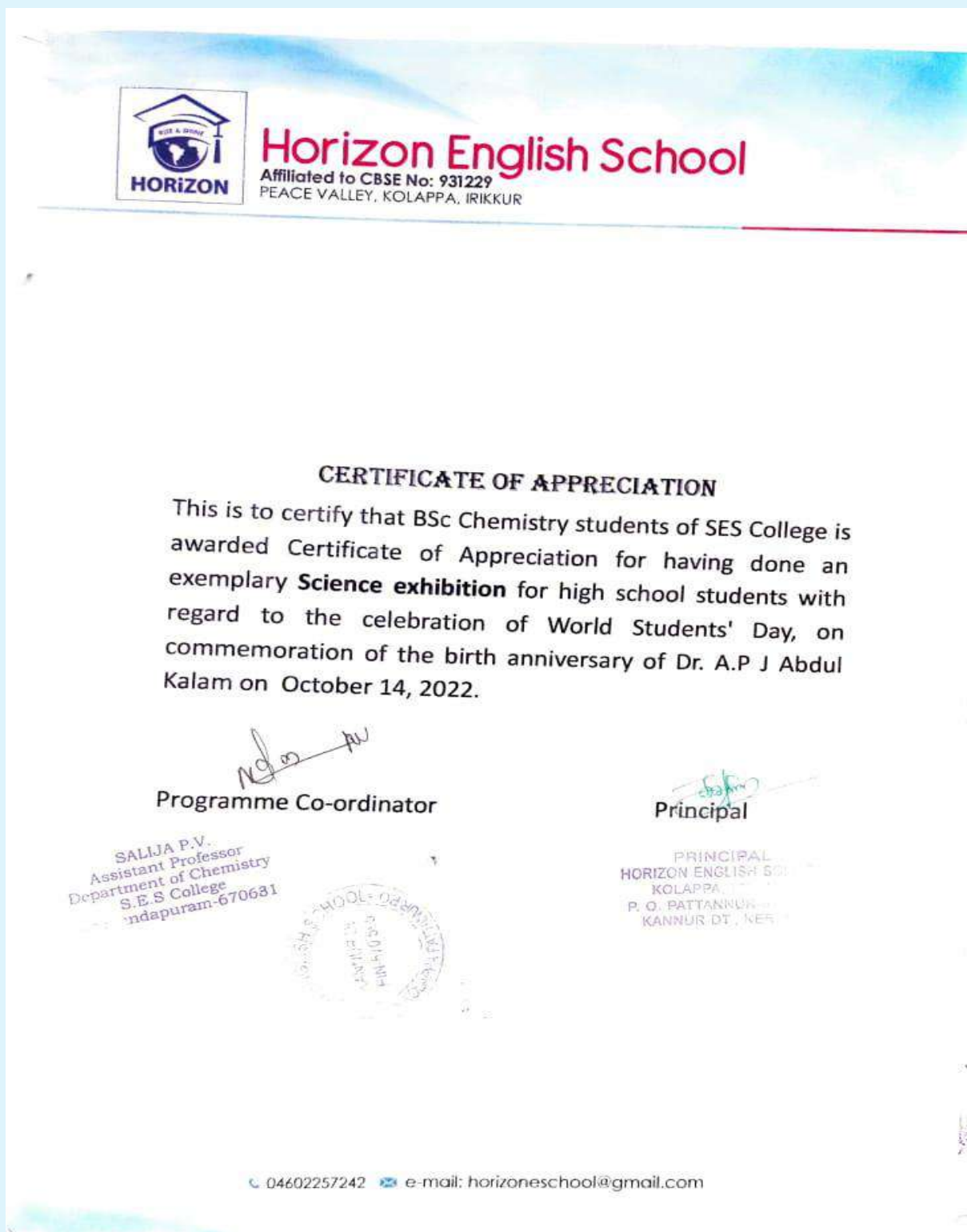


Connecting Science to Society (Academic Extension Activity)

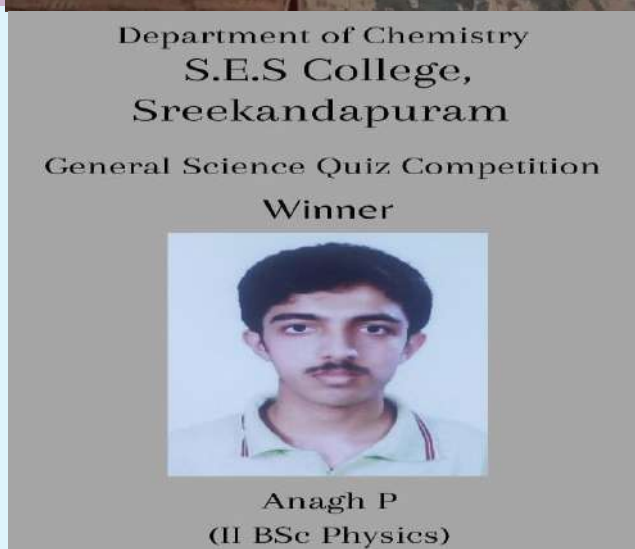
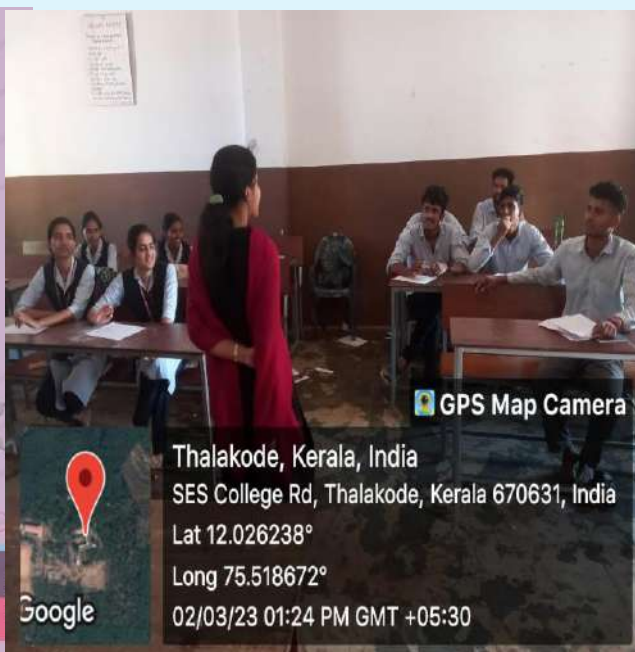
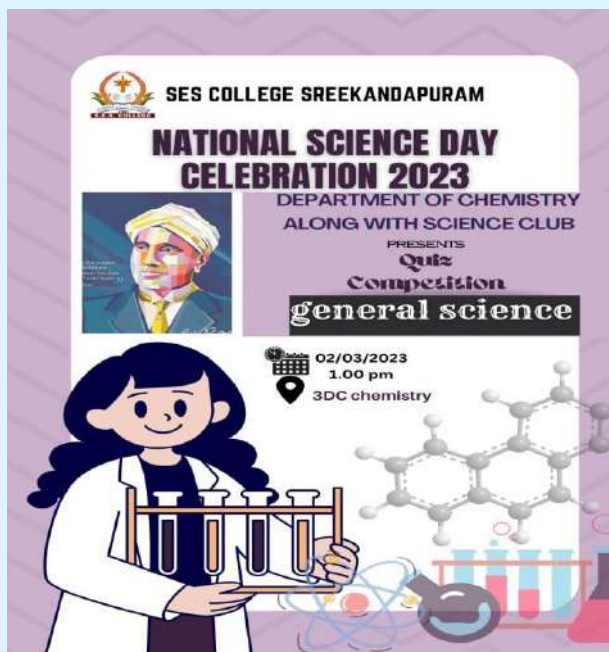
VISIT TO DISTRICT SOIL TESTING LABORATORY

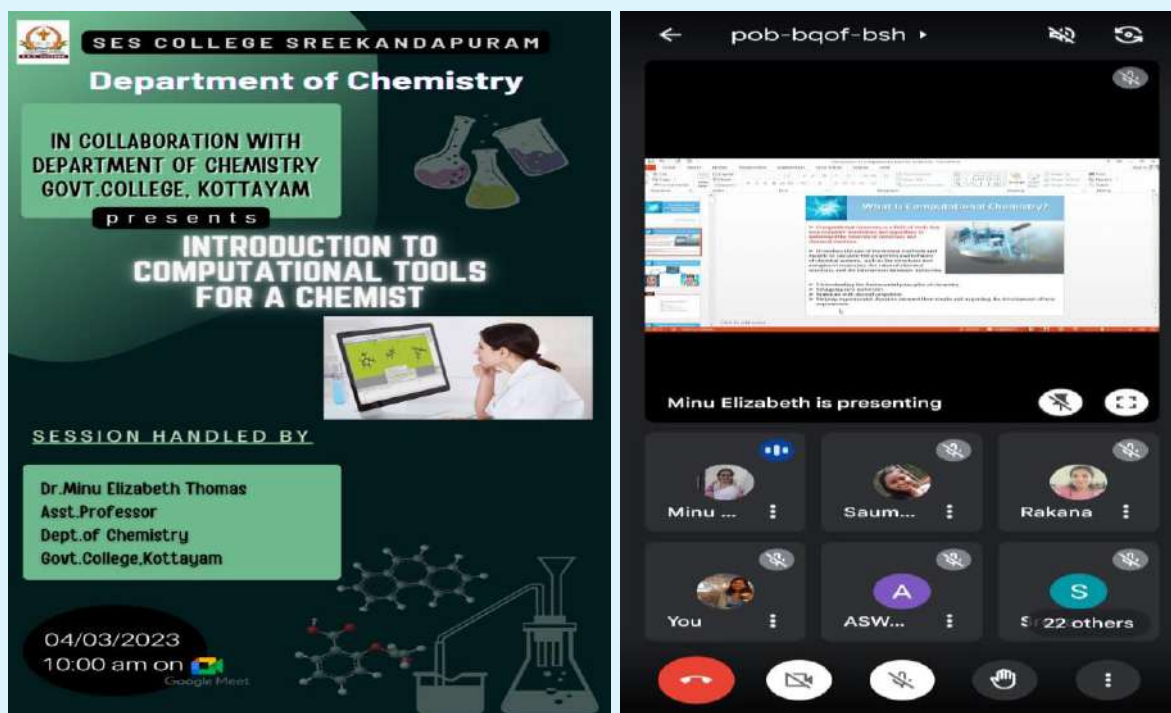
QUIZ COMPETITION (CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY)




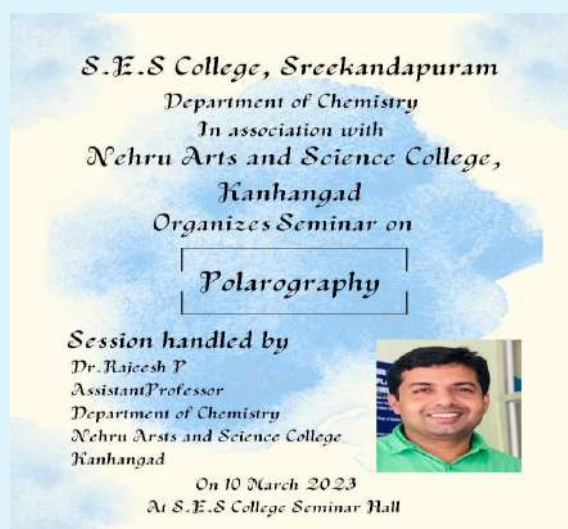
