21/06/2022

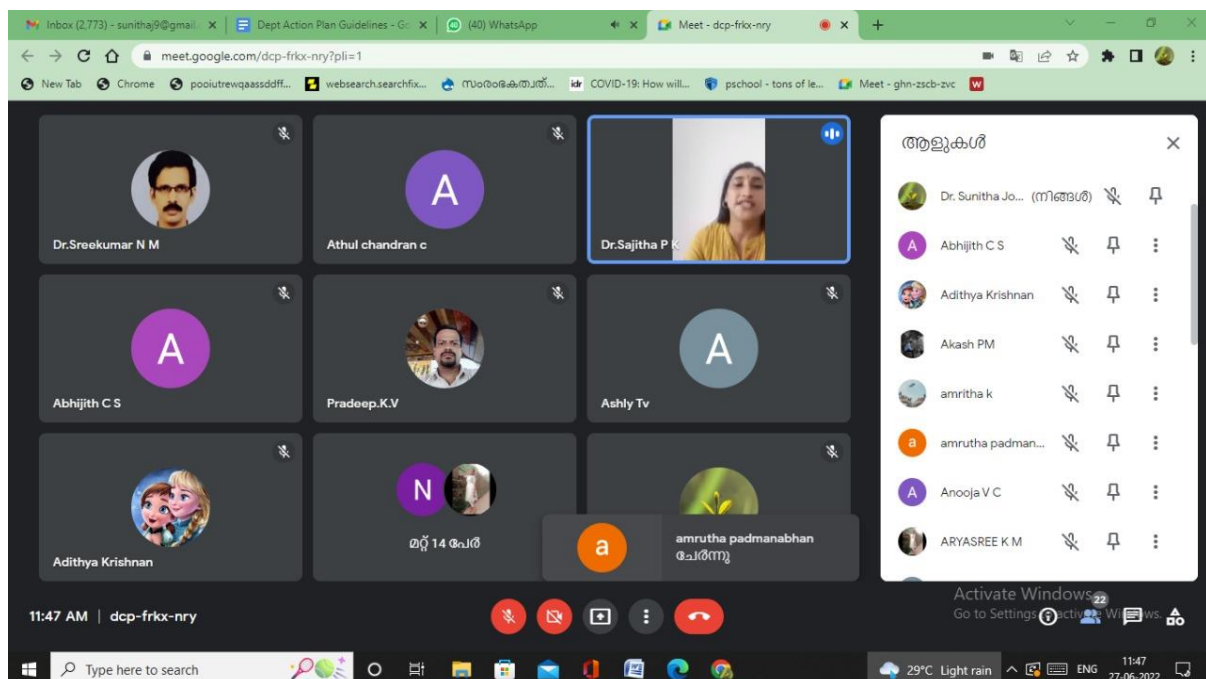

01/11/2022

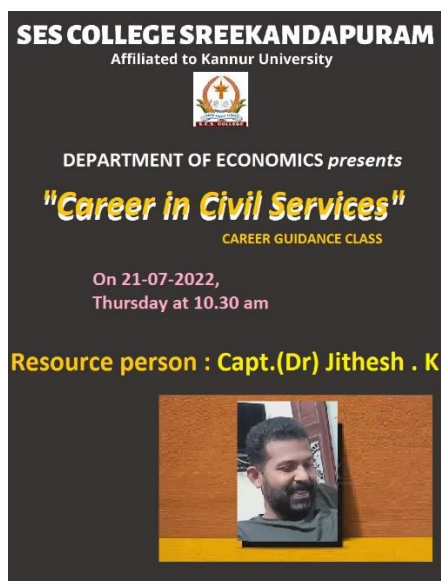
