PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO THE UG DEGREE PROGRAMMES UNDER CHOICE BASED CREDIT AND SEMESTER (OUTCOME BASED EDUCATION) SYSTEM IN THE COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO THE KANNUR UNIVERSITY FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-24

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. Prospectus for admission to the Under Graduate **Degree Programme under Choice Based Credit and Semester (Outcome Based Education) system** in Government/Aided / Self Financing Affiliated Colleges for the academic year 2023-24 as approved by the Kannur University is published. It contains general information and rules relating to the admission **under Choice Based Credit and Semester (OBE) Degree Programmes** in Govt./Aided/Self Financing Affiliated Colleges of the University.
- 1.2. The conduct of the University UG programmes shall be governed by the regulations in force with effect from 2019 admission
- 1.3. Admissions to the seats to be filled by the University for the Under Graduate Degree Programmes (except those specifically mentioned) are regulated on the basis of the marks/grade points obtained in the qualifying examination. The details of seats to which admissions are made through the rank list prepared accordingly are contained in the relevant paragraphs. (Clause 4.1).
- 1.4. As per Kannur University Statute, First statutes 1998 'no student shall be admitted to any course of instruction in the Colleges in anticipation of Affiliation'.
- 1.5. The prospectus issued by the University during the previous years for admission to Under Graduate Degree Programmes is not valid for the year 2023-2024. The prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the University. The applicants are requested to visit the website www.admission.kannuruniversity.ac.in for Notification and announcement.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

Admission to the UG Degree Programme under Choice Based Credit and Semester (OBE) system in the Arts and Science Colleges affiliated to the Kannur University will be made on the basis of Online Centralized Allotment. The Online allotment process will provide the candidates with an opportunity of obtaining admission to any of the Colleges/Programmes of the University of his/her choice on the basis of merit.

Any candidate who desires to obtain admission under the Kannur University for the Degree programme should compulsorily register through online before the closure of registration, irrespective of the Category (General /SEBC/ EWS/ SC/ST/ Community /Management / Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep/Jammu and Kashmir/Persons With Disabilities/ widows /wards of Armed Forces Personnel, killed or disabled in action during peace time/ Sports etc.) to which he/she belongs.

The allotment of the candidates to the various Programmes and Colleges will be on the basis of merit strictly following the rules and regulations regarding reservation. The marks at the Plus Two/Higher Secondary level would be the basic criteria for admission to the Degree Programme. **The students who seek admission in Sports/Community/Management Quota should register through online and submit a copy of the print out to the concerned colleges with a request.**

The University will not be conducting online centralized allotment for the following Degree Programmes and those candidates who wish to apply for the same need to apply directly to the colleges concerned as and when the applications are invited.(In

such cases mentioned below).

- a) B.A. Afsal-UI-Ulama, B.Com. Computer Application(For Hearing impaired) at **Marthoma College for the Hearing Impaired**, Cherkala, Kasaragod, **and UG programmes at PKKM College of Applied Science, Mananthawady** are exempted from the CAP. The students should directly contact the college for admission with relevant certificates.
- b). Candidates seeking admission on passing **SAY** examination during the current Academic year can register online before the supplementary allotment. They will be considered in the supplementary allotment.

2.1 Authority to prescribe qualification for admission to the various courses of studies.

As per Sub-Section (v) and (vi) of Section 27 of the Kannur University Act, 1996, the Academic Council shall have the power to prescribe qualifications for admission of students to the various courses of study (and to the Examinations) and the conditions under which exemptions shall be granted, and to make provision for the admission of students to the various courses of studies on the basis of merit in order to maintain the standards of education.

2.2 Agreement for Direct Payment -Relevant provisions for admission to the various courses in aided colleges.

Article 18 of the Agreement for Direct Payment entered into between the Government and The Educational Agencies of Private Colleges stipulates that all future admission of Students to the private affiliated colleges shall be on the following basis:

- a) Twenty percent of the total number of seats in each college shall be reserved for students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. Those seats which cannot be filled on this basis shall be filled on the basis of merit from among backward minority communities, in the case of colleges run by backward minority communities and by OEC, in all other cases.
- b) ***Ten/Twenty**** percent of the seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to the community to which the college belongs. These seats will be filled strictly on the basis of merit from among the students of the said community.
- c) ***Fifty/Forty**** percent of the seats will be filled by open selection on the basis of merit.
- d) The remaining seats will be filled by the Educational Agency by candidates of their choice.

Note: ** This will apply to colleges run by educational agencies belonging to Forward Community Colleges*

***This will apply to colleges run by educational agencies belonging Backward Community Colleges*

2.3 Age limit: There is no upper age limit for admission to the UG Programme.

3 PROGRAMMES, INSTITUTIONS AND SEATS

3.1 Details of the Programme and Duration: The Programme leads to Bachelors Degree in the relevant subject. Each Programme extends for a period of Six semesters (Three years). The Programme of study shall be by regular attendance for the requisite number of lectures, practical training and other means. **All UG Programmes shall be completed within the maximum period of 6 Years**

3.2 Institutions and Subjects for the UG Degree Programme: The List of Colleges affiliated to the Kannur University and the subjects offered in each institution are given as **Annexure I**, of the Prospectus.

3.3 Categorization of Seats: Seats available in Govt./Aided/Self Financing Affiliated Colleges are mainly classified as Merit Seats, Community Seats, Management Seats and Reservation

Seats.

a) **Merit Seats:** The seats that are filled by the University in Government/Aided/Self -Financing Affiliated Colleges purely on the basis of merit are classified as 'Merit Seats'.

b) **Community Seats:** The seats in Aided Colleges that are filled by the college concerned, from among the candidates who belong to the community of the Management that runs the college, on the basis of merit among their community candidates, are classified as Community seats.

c) **Management Seats:** The seats in Aided and Self-Financing Affiliated Colleges that are filled by the Managements concerned are classified as 'Management Seats'.

d).**Reservation Seats:** The seats in Government/Aided/Self Financing Affiliated Colleges, which are earmarked for SC/ST/SEBC/EWS/PWBD /Transgender persons/ Sports persons, are classified as 'Reservation Seats'.

4 RESERVATION OF SEATS

A candidate can claim only one benefit at a time as per the choice of the candidate for a particular purpose.

4.1 Types of Reservation: Seats will be reserved for the following categories in Government, Aided and Self Financing Affiliated Colleges for various UG Programmes.

- 1) Mandatory Reservation.
- 2) Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PWBD)
- 3) Reservation for Transgender Persons
- 4) Special Reservation and
- 5) Reservation for Nominees

4.1.1 Mandatory Reservation

a). Government Colleges

*** Candidates who enjoy Community Reservation under the category SEBC& SC/ST who have BPL endorsement in the Ration Card are NOT eligible for EWS reservation. Only the candidates belonging to Economically weaker section which does not belong to SC/ST or other backward classes as per reservation rule are eligible for EWS reservation. Such candidates shall produce either of the certificates from the Village Officer namely "The applicant belonging to Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) And Priority House Hold (PHH) category"-(Annexure IV) or "The Income and Assets**

certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)"-(Annexure V)

Note: (a) For obtaining SEBC reservation, Non Creamy Layer Certificate should be produced.

(b) The creation of additional seats in Government colleges shall not incur any additional financial commitment either to Government or to the University..

Note: The seats under community quota in Aided Colleges will be filled by the concerned Management on the basis of merit and on the basis of community certificate issued by the Revenue Authorities/Parish Priest/any other Competent Authority.

Applicants claiming admission under Community quota in Aided Colleges shall belong to the community of the Management which runs the college. They will have to produce any document to prove community/caste/non creamy layer certificate from village officer at the time of admission, to prove their claim.

(c) **Self-Financing /Govt. Cost sharing institutions(IHRD Colleges) Affiliated Colleges:** In Self-financing colleges/Self-financing programmes conducted in Aided colleges, 50 % of the total seats shall be filled by the management from among candidates of their choice provided they satisfy the eligibility conditions. The remaining seats (50%) will be distributed and filled as detailed below:

Mode of admission under Management Quota in Aided, Govt. Cost sharing institutions(IHRD Colleges) and Self Financing Colleges

1. The candidates seeking admission to the Management quota seats in Aided, Govt. Cost sharing institutions and Self- financing colleges should register online.
2. There is no centralized allotment for seats ear marked under Management Quota. Candidates should contact the colleges where the candidate intends to take admission and submit the printout of the online registration application form to the colleges concerned.
3. . After closure of registration for the centralized allotment process, registration exclusively for Management quota seats will be open. The candidates seeking admission under Management Quota alone can apply till the closure of admission.
4. It may be noted that the candidates who have submitted their online application through the Management Quota link will not be considered for the allotment process.
5. **If a candidate has already registered for centralized allotment process, it is sufficient for admission under Management Quota also. There is no need of separate registration under Management Quota.**

Note: The fee structure of the Govt. Cost sharing institutions and Self-financing Colleges is higher than that of Govt. /Aided Colleges

**EWS reservation of 10% shall be additionally created over and above the total strength of seats for all programmes in all institutions which do not have minority status*

Note: EWS reservation will be subject to orders issued by the Govt. from time to time.

CLAIMS FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED

- (i) Claims for Mandatory Reservations must be made by a candidate at the time of submission of online application. Candidates should mention their claim in the **relevant columns** in the Personal and Academic Data Sheet. They should also satisfy the eligibility conditions as per the Prospectus, at the time of online registration.
- (ii) Candidates should produce all original documents to prove their claims made in the online application form, at the time of admission, before the Principal. **The claims that are not mentioned at the time of online submission of application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced later on. The claims for mandatory reservation, once made, cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.**
- (iii) Only candidates belonging to “Keralite” category, are eligible for claiming seats under Mandatory and Special reservation quota unless otherwise specified in the Prospectus.

Claim for Community reservation under ‘Socially and Educationally Backward Classes’ (SEBC):

Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. dated 2.5.1966, as amended from time to time.

(a) As per G.O. (Ms) No.02/2017, Backward Community Development, dated 08/03/2017, candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes under

NON CREAMY LAYER category are eligible for reservation under this category. Non creamy layer certificate is obtained from Village officer concerned. *The validity of the non-creamy layer certificate is one year.*

The candidates belonging to the Communities included in the SEBC list (as detailed in **Annexure II(d)**) alone will be eligible for the benefit of reservation under this category. The seats un-availed by SEBC category candidates will be allotted under Open Quota.

Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes quota (SC/ST)

- (a) Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the caste/community certificate from the Village Officer / Tahsildar. Candidates belonging to SC/ST communities allotted against merit seats or against the seats reserved for them are exempted from payment of fee at the time of admission. *The validity of the SC/ST certificate is three year.*

(SC/ST list is given in Annexure II (a) & II (b))

The seats unavailed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidates and vice versa.

Warning: Those who produce false SC/ST Certificate for claiming reservation under SC/ST quota shall be liable for punishment as per rules.

(b) Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates:

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates are eligible for un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota. **The communities listed in the Annexure(II(c)) only are eligible for such un-availed seats, if any , under SC/ST quota.**(G.O.(Ms)No.14/2017/BCDD dated 02.08.2017).The candidate should furnish any document to prove their community and non-creamy layer certificate obtained from the Village Officer/ Tahsildar concerned, at the time admission.

Converted Christians do not come under the SC/ST category. They belong to OEC category.

(c) Claim for fee concession to OEC candidates:

Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities are exempted from payment of fee at the time of admission to UG Degree Programme under Government/Community quota irrespective of annual family income as per G.O (MS) No. 36/07/SCSTDD, dated: 03.07.2007. They should produce any document to prove their community. (the communities listed in the **Annexure II(c)**)

(d) Claim for fee concession to the candidates who get OEC educational assistance:

As per the G.O.(Ms) 10/2014/BCDD dated 23.05.2014, 30 communities from state OBC list are selected for OEC educational assistance subject to a maximum of Rs. 6 Lakh annual income. (G.O (MS) No.03/2018/BCDD) dated 09.04.2018 (Communities listed in **Annexure II(e)**).They should provide any document to prove their community and Income Certificates from the Village Officer at the time of admission. (The validity of income certificate of OEC community is one year.)

Claims for Reservation under Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category

Candidates who enjoy Communal Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST are NOT eligible for EWS reservation. **Only the candidates belonging to Economically weaker section which does not belong to SC/ST or other backward classes as per**

reservation rule are eligible for EWS reservation. Communities who are economically backward are eligible for EWS Reservation. Such candidates must produce either of the certificates from the Village Officer namely “The applicant belonging to Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category”- (Annexure IV) or “The Income and Assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category (**Annexure V**).

OTHER GENERAL RULES FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION

General Rules for conversion of vacant seats

The seats un-availed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidate and vice versa. If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates, the same will be notified in the media and a separate allotment for SC/ST candidates will be made by the University. However, even after this, if SC/ST seats remains vacant such seats shall be filled as detailed below.

Government/Aided Colleges except Colleges run by Backward Minority Communities:

The unfilled seats shall be filled up from the candidates belonging to OEC(Annexure II(c)), and in their absence candidates belonging to SEBC.

If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SEBC, the seats that remain unfilled will be converted to the General Merit Quota.

Aided Colleges run by Backward Minority Communities: The unfilled seats shall be filled on the basis of the merit as per the rank list from among the applicants of backward minority community, which runs the college. If seats still remain unfilled, it will be filled up from candidates belonging to OEC (Annexure II(c)) and in their absence, candidates belonging to SEBC. The seats that further remain unfilled will go to the open quota.

4.1.2 Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PWBD):

(i) 5% of the total seats, over and above the sanctioned strength will be set apart exclusively for persons with benchmark disabilities in each programme.

As per Clause 2(r), Chapter I of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, ‘Person with benchmark disability’ means a person suffering from not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority. Candidates seeking admission under PWBD category should submit the ‘Certificate of disability’ (permanent), by the District Medical Board or bodies of higher status, certifying the degree of percentage of disability. Based on the details furnished in the online application, candidates will be provisionally included under the ‘Persons with Benchmark Disability’ category.

(ii) Maximum of three seats have been reserved in Govt./aided Colleges for the admission of candidates with autism/ intellectual disability/ specific learning disability/ mental illness(considering all these four categories as one unit) by creating additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength in all programmes

Note: The selection of candidates under this category will be based on the rank in the inter-merit list and physical suitability and not on the basis of the degree of disability.
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No reservation of seat is allowed for Blind candidates for Science subjects.
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4.1.3 Reservation for Transgender Persons

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength in all programmes in affiliated Arts & Science Colleges exclusively for admitting Transgender students.

(G.O.(Ms)No.153/2018 HEDn dated 03.07.2018). Such candidates should submit transgender identity card issued by the State Government at the time of admission.

(G.O. (Ms.) No. 295/2021/HEDN dated 07/07/2021).

4.1.4 SPECIAL RESERVATION

Sportsperson

- i. Two seats in each U.G. Programme will be reserved for candidates with outstanding records in sports and games. The seats will be allotted **by creating additional seats over and above** the sanctioned strength. If eligible sports persons are not available the unfilled seats should be kept vacant.
- ii. Criteria for sanctioning additional seats for outstanding sportspersons for UG admission
 - a) Additional seats shall be sanctioned within the statutory limit.
 - b) The recommendation for the same from the concerned college Principal shall be verified and recommended by the Director of Physical Education, Kannur University
 - c) The minimum achievement for additional seats shall be as per Sl. No. 20 of the Sports Quota norms of Kannur University (i.e., Representing the Zone/Revenue District Sports School/ Sports Hostel/ School in the Kerala State School Championships and Winning a Medal)

- Minimum achievements for UG admission under Sports Quota will be a place in the Revenue District competition (22 marks).
- II and III positions are included as criteria for Sports Quota admissions in U.G. courses.

Explanations

1. Achievements in those sports disciplines approved by Association of Indian Universities only will be considered for Sports Quota Admissions.
2. Priority shall be given while preparing rank list for those events in which Kannur University conducts inter collegiate competitions.
3. Approved World Competitions means the Competitions organized by the International Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline and in which the national Teams are sponsored by the National Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline and in which the National teams are sponsored by the National Apex Bodies and cleared by Sports Authority of India/ Government of India.
4. The National Championship means the Championships conducted by the National Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline. District Competition means revenue district competition conducted by district association in respective sports, regional competitions means competition organized by KV/Navodaya/CBSE in the regional basis.
5. Games/ Events mean a game/ event in which individual performs alone.
6. When a candidate has number of achievement in a sports / different discipline his/ her best achievement will be taken into consideration.

7. The sports achievements in last four years shall be considered for Sports Quota admissions of UG courses for this academic year 2023-24.
8. All competitions where an upper age limit is fixed (Youth/ Junior/ Sub-Junior) would be treated as junior event provided it is not classified as senior event by the concerned National Federation.
9. Priority will be given for students having achievements in senior level competitions
10. When there is tie in the rank/mark the following criteria will be applied to break the tie:
 - (a) Priority will be given as per of their order of merit i.e.; 1st, 2nd and 3rd place respectively.
 - (b) If the tie still remains those with a more number of achievements in the same level will be placed above the others. (more number of I places, more number of II places and so on.)
 - (c) If the ties still remains the next best achievement as per the order merit will be considered.
 - (d) If the tie is not broken by the above method the person having the achievements during the year closer to the selection will be given higher rank.
 - (e) Individual achievements will be ranked above team achievements.
 - (f) A new record is created; he/she will be given priority.
 - (g) If a tie cannot be broken by any of the above mentioned sports achievements, the marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be considered for breaking the tie.

NOTE:

The Sports Quota candidates should also register through online before the closure of registration date. The student should submit printout of the application (along with copies of sports certificates) to the Principal of the concerned college with a request. The Principal thereafter, with the help of Physical Education Department of the college will prepare a rank list as per the University norms. The rank list should be published in the college notice board for student's redressal for a minimum of three days for the final publication of the rank list.

If vacancies arise due to discontinuation of candidates under Sports quota, the next eligible candidate in the Rank List (Sports quota) shall be admitted. In case there is no next eligible candidate, the unfilled seat shall be kept vacant.

4.1.4. Reservation for Nominees

i)Reservation for Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep.

An additional seat shall be created for each UG Degree Programme (wherever necessary) in all Affiliated Colleges, exclusively for the purpose of accommodating students sponsored by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates.

ii) Concession for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in Kashmir valley

The following relevant concessions are applicable for wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in Kashmir valley for admission to the UG courses in all Affiliated Arts & Science Colleges.

- Relaxation in cut off percentage up to 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- Increase in intake capacity up to 5% course wise.
- Waiving of domicile requirements for Kashmiri Migrants only. Kashmiri Pandits / Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in the Kashmir valley need domicile certificate.

iii) Reservation for Candidates from Jammu and Kashmir.

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength to accommodate candidates belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to UG programmes in the Affiliated Colleges.

iv) Reservation for Kannada Linguistic Minority (KLM).

5% seats have been reserved for the students belonging to the following Linguistic Minority group in Govt. Colleges as detailed below as per order no. G.O. (Ms.) No. 148/96/H.Edn. dated 1st August 1996. The seats will be additionally created over and above the sanctioned seats in all programmes

1. Government college, Manjeswaram –Kannada Linguistic Minority
2. Government college, Kasaragod – Kannada Linguistic Minority

If there is no eligible candidate for the admission to KLM reservation, the unfilled seats shall be kept vacant.

v) Reservation for Urdu Linguistic Minority (ULM)

2% seats have been reserved for the students belonging to Urdu Linguistic Minority group in Govt. Colleges as detailed below as per order no. G.O. (Ms.) No. 167/67/Edn. dated 15/04/1967

The seats will be additionally created over and above the sanctioned seats in all programmes.

1. Government Brennen College, Thalassery.

In the absence of those who have studied Urdu as second language in higher secondary, those who have studied Urdu in SSLC will be considered for admission. If there is no eligible candidate for admission to ULM reservation, the unfilled seats shall be kept vacant.

vi) Reservation of seats for the widows /wards of Armed Forces of Personnel, killed/disabled in action during peace time.

Additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength may be created as and when required for the widows /wards of Armed Forces Personnel, killed or disabled in action during peace time, in Central /State Universities /Autonomous/ Professional / Non-Professional Institutions under the purview of Ministry of Human Resource Development as per UGC policy. (Applicable to Army/Navy/Airforce only. Not applicable to paramilitary forces/CAPF/GREF/Coast Guard etc.). Certificates in proof of claim with supporting documents to be produced at the time of admission.

5. RULES FOR ADMISSION OF STUDENTS TO VARIOUS UG DEGREE PROGRAMME IN AFFILIATED COLLEGES

- 5.1. Assessment of Merit:** Except when otherwise provided, the merit of a candidate will be assessed on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidate in the qualifying examinations for admission to the particular programmes, subject to such criteria as may be prescribed by the University. In assessing merit, marks will be awarded for extracurricular activities like sports, NCC, NSS, SPC etc. of the students. These marks will be added to the marks obtained for the qualifying examination for preparing the rank list.

5.1.1. Weightage:-

1. The candidates who have attended NSS/NCC/SPC/ during the period of the qualifying examinations ie, plus two only will be eligible for the bonus mark. The Certificate issued by the Director of NSS/NCC only will be considered for bonus mark in respect of NSS/NCC candidates.

2. The candidates who got Rajyamudra/ Nanmamudra certificate in Scouts/ Guides/ Ranger/ Rower in higher secondary level are eligible for bonus marks of 15.

Note:

- a) In respect of NCC applicants, the bonus marks will be awarded, on the basis of N.C.C. Certificates signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of N.C.C., to the candidates who have secured at least 75% of attendance after having participated in its activities during the course of study immediately preceding the Programme for which admission is sought.
- b) For awarding bonus marks to N.S.S. Participants, the basis will be N.S.S. Certificates signed by the Competent Authority.
- c) For awarding bonus mark to SPC, the certificate signed by the Competent Authority shall be submitted.
- d) The benefit of bonus marks (15 marks) for purposes of admission can be earned by the candidates only under any one category (N.S.S./N.C.C./S.P.C./Scouts/ Guides/ Ranger/ Rower). An additional weightage of 5 or 10 marks will be awarded to NCC cadets holding B or C Certificates respectively.
- e) The weightage of bonus marks shall be added to the marks scored by the candidate either to

make him/her eligible for admission to a Programme or for ranking purposes to those who are otherwise eligible for admission. In the case of candidates who get the eligibility by this bonus marks, their ranking mark will be the sum of scored marks and the bonus marks.

Note: Weightage mark will be subject to the decision of Syndicate

g) Ex-Servicemen & their dependants

A weightage of 15 marks will be given to the ex-servicemen and widows and children of Jawans and Ex-servicemen for admission (Applicable to Army/Navy/Air force only. Not applicable to paramilitary forces/CAPF/GREF/Coast Guard etc.). Certificates in proof of claim with supporting documents to be produced at the time of admission.

5.1.2. The Candidates who have passed qualifying exam under CISCE or any other boards which have more than three electives will have to submit more than one application with different electives, in case they wish to seek admission for all the electives they have studied.

For example a candidate who chooses Mathematics as elective should compulsorily enter the marks of Mathematics plus the marks of any other two electives as per their choice of that stream. This is applicable for all other subjects.

Such candidates will have to submit separate applications with separate registration fee.

5.2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

5.2.1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Statutes, the selection of students in Government colleges shall be governed by the rules prescribed by the Government from time to time with the concurrence of the University in respect of such admissions.

“A pass in Higher Secondary Examination/Vocational Higher Secondary Examination of the Government of Kerala or an Examination accepted by the Academic Council of the university as equivalent thereto”.

N.B. For subjects which are not being offered at the qualifying Examination level, the marks of related subject or subjects, knowledge of which is essential for the study of the subject proposed to be chosen for the UG Degree Programme, shall be added to the total marks for the purpose of ranking.

6.1 Standardization of marks for admission to UG Degree Programme under CBCS system – Guidelines issued (2010-2011 onwards).

a). In the case of Higher Secondary Examination from 2010 onwards, the index marks are to be calculated as follows.

Total marks secured for Higher Secondary + Marks secured in the concerned subject

For e.g. If the student has secured 800 marks out of the total 1200 marks and if he has secured 150 out of 200 in mathematics, his index marks will be $800 + 150 = 950$.

In the case of admission to B.A English, the marks obtained for English is doubled and added to the total mark. If the student in the above example has secured 120 marks out of 200 in English, his index mark will be $800 + 240 = 1040$

b). In the case of VHSE students from 2021 onwards, the index marks are to be calculated as follows

Total marks secured for VHSE [English +Entrepreneurship Development+ Vocational Theory(out of 200) +3 optionals] + Marks secured in the concerned subject

For e.g. If the student has secured 800 marks out of the total 1200 marks and if he has secured 150 out of 200 in mathematics, his index marks will be $800 + 150 = 950$.

In the case of admission to U.G. Degree Programme in English (if scored 150 marks out of 200 in English) Index marks = $800+300 =1100$.

c). In the case of other Boards such as CBSE and CISCE, normalize the total marks to 1200 and then add TWICE THE PERCENTAGE of marks obtained in the concerned subject.

For Example: If a student has secured 400 out of the total of 500 marks in the CBSE stream and if he has say, secured 80 marks out of 100 in mathematics, his index marks will be $400/500 \times 1200$ plus 160 (i.e, 80×2) marks of mathematics. That is $960 + 160 =1120$. In the case of

admission to UG Degree Programme in English, quadruple (4 times) the marks obtained for English and add to the normalized total marks.

For eg: If the student in example above secured 70 out of 100 marks in English, then his index mark will be

$$960 + 280 = 1240$$

The benefit of bonus marks (15 marks) for purposes of admission can be earned by the candidates only under any one category (either N.S.S. or N.C.C. or S.P.C. or Scouts/ Guides/ Ranger/ Rower(Nanmamudra/Rajyamudra certificates)). An additional Weightage of 5, 10 marks will be awarded to NCC cadets holding B, C Certificates respectively

Weightage of 10 marks shall be awarded as bonus marks to the applicants of Government & Aided colleges belonging to the district in which the college is situated.
Weightage of 10 marks to the applicants of UG Programme in unaided colleges at Taluk level
Weightage of 20 marks to the ST applicants of Wayanad district for admission in Arts & Science colleges of Wayanad District under the Jurisdiction of Kannur University as per order No. Acad./D2/2805/2017 dated 20/04/2017.

- Date of Birth (older be placed higher in ranking)

6.4 Deductions /Loosing of marks for subsequent appearances

Candidates will lose 10 marks for ranking purpose for every successive attempt after the first attempt of qualifying examination, subject to a maximum of 25 marks. The number of chances means the number of chances taken for passing any part of the qualifying examination. Betterment of examination will not be considered as a chance.

6.5. Fee to be paid to the University

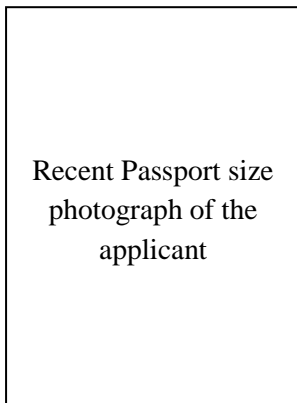

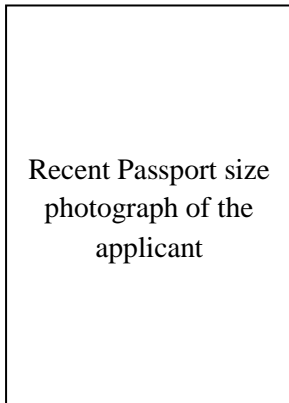

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. Prospectus for admission to the **Post Graduate Degree Programme Under Credit Based Semester System** in Government/Aided/IHRD (Govt. cost sharing) Self Financing Affiliated Colleges for the Academic year 2023-24, as approved by the Kannur University, is published. It contains general information and rules relating to the admission to the **Credit Based Semester System of Post Graduate Degree Programmes** in Govt./Aided/IHRD (Govt. cost sharing) Self Financing Affiliated Colleges of the University.
- 1.2. Admissions to the seats to be filled by the University for the Post Graduate Degree Programmes (except those specifically mentioned) are regulated on the basis of the marks/grade points obtained in the qualifying examination. The details of seats to which admissions are made through the rank list prepared accordingly are contained in the relevant paragraphs. (Clause 4.1).
- 1.3. As per Kannur University First Statutes 1998, 'no student shall be admitted to any course of instruction in the Colleges in anticipation of Affiliation'.
- 1.4. **The prospectus issued by the University during the previous years for admission to Post Graduate Degree Programmes is not valid for the year 2023-2024. The prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the University. The applicants are requested to visit the website <https://admission.kannuruniversity.ac.in> for notification and announcement.**

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

The admission to the PG Degree Programme under **Credit Based Semester System** in the Arts and Science Colleges affiliated to the Kannur University will be made on the basis of **Online Centralized Allotment**. **The Online allotment process** will provide the candidates with an opportunity of obtaining admission to any of the Colleges/Programmes of the University of the choice of the candidate on the basis of merit.

Any candidate who desires to obtain admission under the Kannur University for the Post Graduate Degree Programme should compulsorily register through online before the closure of registration, irrespective of the Category (General /SEBC/ EWS/ SC/ST/ Community /Management / Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep/ Jammu and Kashmir/Persons With Disabilities/ widows /wards of Armed Forces Personnel, killed or disabled in action during peace time/ Sports etc.) to which the candidate belongs .

The rank list of the candidates to the various Programmes and Colleges will be on the basis of merit strictly following the rules and regulations regarding reservation.

The students who seek admission in Sports/Community/Management Quota should register through online and submit a copy of the print out to the concerned colleges with a request.

The University will not be conducting online centralized allotment for the following PG Programmes/Courses and those candidates who wish to apply for the same need to apply directly to the colleges concerned as and when the applications are invited.

1. **M.Com programme at PKKM college, Mananthawady**

2. MBA & MCA programmes at colleges.

2.1 Authority to prescribe qualification for admission to the various courses of studies.

As per Sub-Section (v) and (vi) of Section 27 of the Kannur University Act, 1996, the Academic Council shall have the power to prescribe qualifications for admission of students to the various courses of study (and to the Examinations) and the conditions under which exemptions shall be granted, and to make provision for the admission of students to the various courses of studies on the basis of merit in order to maintain the standards of education.

2.2 Agreement for Direct Payment -Relevant provisions for admission to the various programmes in aided colleges.

Article 18 of the Agreement for Direct Payment entered into between the Government and the Educational Agencies of Private Colleges stipulates that all future admission of students to the private affiliated colleges shall be on the following basis, viz :

- a) Twenty percentage of the total number of seats in each college shall be reserved for students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. Those seats which cannot be filled on this basis shall be filled on the basis of merit from among backward minority communities, in the case of colleges run by backward minority communities and by OEC, in all other cases.
- b) *Ten/Twenty** percentage of the seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to the community to which the college belongs. These seats will be filled strictly on the basis of merit from among the students of the said community.
- c) *Fifty/Forty ** percentage of the seats will be filled by open selection on the basis of merit.
- d) 20% of the seats for admission will be reserved as management quota

Note: * This will apply to colleges run by educational agencies belonging to Forward Community .

**This will apply to colleges run by education agencies belonging to Backward Community.

3 PROGRAMMES, INSTITUTIONS AND SEATS

3.1 Details of the Programme and Duration: The Programme leads to Post Graduate Degree in the relevant subject. Each Programme extends for a period of four semesters. The Programme of study will be by regular attendance for the requisite number of lectures, practical training and other means. All PG programmes shall be completed within the maximum period of four years.

3.2 Institutions and Subjects for the PG Degree Programme: The List of Colleges affiliated to the Kannur University and the subject offered in each institution is given as **Annexure I**, of the Prospectus.

3.3 Categorization of Seats: Seats available in Govt./Aided/Self-Financing Affiliated Colleges are mainly classified as Merit Seats, Community Seats, Management Seats and Reservation Seats

- a) **Merit Seats:** The seats that are filled by the University in Government/Aided/Self -Financing Affiliated Colleges purely on the basis of merit are classified as 'Merit Seats'.
- b) **Community Seats:** The seats in Aided Colleges that are filled by the Management concerned, on the basis of merit among their community candidates, are classified as 'Community Seats'
- c) **Management Seats:** The seats in Aided and Self-financing Affiliated Colleges that are filled by the Managements concerned are classified as 'Management

Seats’.

- d) **Reservation Seats:** The seats in Government/Aided/Self-financing Affiliated Colleges, which are earmarked for SC/ST/SEBC/EWS/PWBD/ Sports persons/ Transgender Persons are classified as ‘Reservation Seats’

4 RESERVATION OF SEATS

A candidate can claim only one benefit at a time as per the candidate’s choice for a particular purpose.

4.1 **Types of Reservation:** Seats will be reserved for the following categories in Govt., Aided and Self-Financing Affiliated Colleges for various PG Degree Programmes.

I) Mandatory Reservation

II) Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PWBD)

III) Reservation for Transgender Persons

IV) Special Reservation and

V) Reservation for Nominees

4.1.1 Mandatory Reservation

The remaining seats (50%) shall be distributed and filled as detailed below

Note: The fee structure of the Self-financing Colleges is higher than that of Govt./Aided Colleges

Mode of admission under Management Quota in Aided and Self Financing Colleges

1. The candidates seeking admission to the management quota seats in Aided and Self Financing colleges should register online.
2. There is no centralized allotment for Management Quota. Candidates should contact the colleges to take admission and submit the printout of the application form to the colleges concerned.
3. After closure of registration for the centralized allotment process, registration exclusively for management quota seats will be open. The candidates seeking admission under Management Quota alone can apply till the closure of admission.
4. It may be noted that the candidates who have submitted their online application through the Management Quota link will not be considered for the allotment process.
5. If a candidate has already registered for centralized allotment process, it is sufficient for admission under management quota also. There is no need of separate registration under management quota.

****EWS reservation of 10% shall be additionally created over and above the total strength of seats for all programmes in all institutions which do not have minority status***

Note: EWS reservation will be subject to orders issued by the Govt. from time to time.

4.1.2 Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PWBD):

- (i) 5% of the total seats, over and above the sanctioned strength will be set apart exclusively for persons with benchmark disabilities in each programme.

As per Clause 2(r), Chapter I of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, 'Person with benchmark disability' means a person suffering from not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority. Candidates seeking admission under PWBD category should submit the 'Certificate of disability' (permanent), by the District Medical Board or bodies of higher status, certifying the degree of percentage of disability. Based on the details furnished in the online application, candidates will be provisionally included under the 'Persons with Benchmark Disability' category.

Note: The selection of candidates under this category will be based on the rank in the inter-se-merit list and physical suitability and not on the basis of the Degree of disability.

No reservation of seat is allowed for Blind candidates for Science subjects.

One seat above the sanctioned strength has been reserved to Govt./Aided colleges for the admission of candidates with Autism/intellectual disability, Specific Learning Disability, Mental Illness etc.

4.1.3 Reservation for Transgender Persons

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength in all courses in affiliated Arts & Science Colleges exclusively for admitting Transgender students. (G.O.(Ms)No.153/2018 HEdn dated 03.07.2018). Such candidates should submit transgender identity card issued by the State Government at the time of admission.

(G.O. (Ms.) No. 295/2021/HEDN dated 05/07/2021).

4.1.4 SPECIAL RESERVATION

Sports Quota: Aggregate all sports seats (P.G.) in colleges in one single sports pool and

distribute seats accordingly. Also admit one or more sportspersons in the same subject as per the merit through additional seat

- i. A minimum of one seat will be reserved for PG course in a College, if the total PG seats are less than 20.
- ii. The sports quota seats for PG course will be given over and above the sanctioned strength of the course.

Criteria for sanctioning additional seats for outstanding sportspersons for PG admission

- a) Additional seats shall be sanctioned within the statutory limit.
- b) The recommendation for the same from the concerned college Principal shall be verified and recommended by the Director, Department of Physical Education , Kannur University
- c)The Sports quota additional seat in PG courses in colleges should be sanctioned only if it is meant for team formations/team building / maintaining of a team in a particular sports discipline or should be a SAI or Kerala State Sports Council hostel inmate/ trainee
- d) The minimum achievement for additional seats shall be as per Sl. No. 20 of the Sports Quota norms of Kannur University(ie, Representing the Zone/Revenue District Sports School/Sports Hostel/ School in the Kerala State School Championships and Winning a Medal)

Explanations

1. Achievements in those sports disciplines approved by Association of Indian Universities only will be considered for Sports Quota Admissions.
2. Priority shall be given while preparing rank list for those events in which Kannur University conducts inter collegiate competitions.
3. Approved World Competitions means the Competitions organized by the International Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline and in which the national Teams are sponsored by the National Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline and in which the National teams are sponsored by the National Apex Bodies and cleared by Sports Authority of India/ Government of India.
4. The National Championship means the Championships conducted by the National Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline. District Competition means revenue district competition conducted by district association in respective sports, regional competitions means competition organized by KV/Navodaya/CBSE in the regional basis.
5. Games/ events mean a game/ event in which individual performs alone.
6. When a candidate has number of achievement in a sports / different discipline his/ her best achievement will be taken into consideration.
7. The sports achievements in last four years (subject to the decision of sports advising committee) shall be considered for Sports quota admissions of PG courses for the academic year 2023-24.
8. All competitions where an upper age limit is fixed (Youth/ Junior/ Sub-Junior) would be treated as junior event provided it is not classified as senior event by the concerned National Federation.

9. Priority will be given for students having achievements in senior level competitions
10. When there is tie in the rank/mark the following criteria will be applied to break the tie:
- Priority will be given as per of their order of merit i.e.; 1st, 2nd and 3rd place respectively.
 - If the tie still remains those with a more number of achievements in the same level will be placed above the others. (more number of I places, more number of II places and so on.)
 - If the ties still remains the next best achievement as per the order merit will be considered.
 - If the tie is not broken by the above method the person having the achievements during the year closer to the selection will be given higher rank.
 - Individual achievements will be ranked above team achievements.
 - A new record is created; such candidate will be given priority.
 - If a tie cannot be broken by any of the above mentioned sports achievements, the marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be considered for breaking the tie.

NOTE:

The Sports Quota candidates should also register through online before the closure of registration date. The student should submit printout of the application (along with copies of sports certificates) to the Physical Education Department of the concerned college with a request. The Principal thereafter, with the help of Physical Education Department of the college will prepare a rank list as per the University norms. The rank list should be published in the college notice board for student's Redressal for a minimum of three days for the final publication of the ranklist.

If vacancies arise due to discontinuation of candidates under Sports quota, the next eligible candidate in the Rank List (Sports quota) shall be admitted. In case there is no next eligible candidate, the seat shall be kept vacant

4.1.5 Reservation for Nominees

i) Reservation for Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep.

An additional seat shall be created for each PG Degree Programme (wherever necessary) in all affiliated colleges, exclusively for the purpose of accommodating students sponsored by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates. The Head of the Institutions should forward the list of such candidates to the University after admission. (Govt. letter No.5455/B3/2006/H.Edn. dated 15-3-2006).

ii) Concession for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in Kashmir valley

The following relevant concessions are applicable for wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in Kashmir valley for admission to the PG programmes in all Affiliated Arts & Science Colleges.

- Relaxation in cut off percentage up to 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- Increase in intake capacity up to 5% course wise.
- Waiving of domicile requirements for Kashmiri Migrants only. Kashmiri Pandits / Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in the Kashmir valley need domicile certificate.

iii) Reservation for Candidates from Jammu and Kashmir.

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength to accommodate candidates belonging to Jammu Kashmir for admission to PG programmes in the affiliated colleges for the academic year 2023-24

iv) Reservation for students from Mahe

One additional seat shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength in 3 Government colleges, as detailed below, to accommodate candidates belonging to Mahe. In the absence of students from Mahe, no admission shall be done among the students of Kerala in those additional seats.

(v) Reservation of seats for the widows /wards of Armed Forces of Personnel killed/disabled in action during peace time.

Additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength may be created as and when required for the widows /wards of Armed Forces Personnel killed or disabled in action during peace time, in Central /State Universities /Autonomous/ Professional / Non-Professional Institutions under the purview of Ministry of Human Resource Development as per UGC policy.(Applicable to Army/Navy/Airforce only. Not applicable to paramilitary forces/CAPF/GREF/Coast Guard etc.). Certificates in proof of claim with supporting documents to be produced at the time of admission.

5. CLAIMS FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED

(i) Claims for Mandatory Reservations must be made by a candidate at the time of submission of online application. Candidates should mention their claim in the **relevant columns** in the Personal and Academic Data Sheet. They should also satisfy the eligibility conditions as per the Prospectus, at the time of online registration.

(ii) Candidates should produce all original documents to prove their claims made in the online application form, at the time of admission, before the Principal. **The claims that are not mentioned at the time of online submission of application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced later on.** *The claims for mandatory reservation, once made, cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.*

5.1.1 Claim for Community reservation under 'Socially and Educationally Backward Classes' (SEBC):

Reservation of seats to the socially and Educationally backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 02.5.1966, as amended from time to time.

(a) As per G.O. (Ms) No.02/2017, Backward Community Development, dated 08/03/2017, candidates belong to socially and Educationally Backward Classes under NON CREAMY LAYER category are eligible for reservation under this category. The candidates belonging to the Communities included in the SEBC list (**List is in the annexure II(d)**) alone will be eligible for the benefit of reservation under this category. The candidates, claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce 'Non Creamy Layer Certificate' obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Validity of the Non creamy Layer Certificate is one year.

5.1.2 Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes quota

Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the caste/community certificate from the Tahsildar. Candidates belonging to SC/ST communities allotted against merit seats or against the seats reserved for them are exempted from payment of fee at the time of admission. *The validity of SC/ST certificate is three years.*

(SC/ST list is given in Annexure II (a) & II (b))

Warning: Those who produce false SC/ST Certificate for claiming reservation under SC/ST quota shall be liable for punishment as per rules.

5.1.3 Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates.

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates are eligible for un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota. The Communities listed in the Annexure II(c) only are eligible for such un-availed seats, if any under, SC/ST quota.(G.O.(Ms)No.14/2017/BCDD dated 02.08.2017). The

candidates should furnish any document to prove their community and non-creamy layer certificate from the Village Officer/Tahsildar.

Converted Christians do not come under the SC/ST category. They belong to OEC category.

5.1.4 Claim for fee concession to OEC candidates:

Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities are exempted from payment of fee at the time of allotment to PG Degree Programme under Government/Community quota irrespective of annual family income as per G.O (MS) No. 36/07/SCSTDD, dated: 03.07.2007.(Communities listed in Annexure II(c)). They should produce any document to prove their Community at the time of admission.

5.1.5 Claim for fee concession to the candidates who get OEC educational assistance.

As per the G.O.(Ms) 10/2014/BCDD dated 23.05.2014, 30 communities from state OBC list are selected for OEC educational assistance subjected to a maximum of Rs. 8 Lakh annual income. (G.O (MS) No. 03/2018/BCDD) dated 09.04.2018 (Communities listed in Annexure II(e)) They should provide any document to prove their Community and Income Certificates from the Village Officer at the time of admission. The validity of income certificate for OEC is one year.

5.1.6 Claims for Reservation under Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category

Candidates who enjoy Communal Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST are NOT eligible for EWS reservation. **Only the candidates belonging to Economically weaker section which does not belong to SC/ST or other backward classes (SEBC/OEC) as per reservation rule are eligible for EWS Reservation (Categories specified in the Annexure II (f)).** Such candidates must produce either of the certificates from the Village Officer namely “The applicant belonging to Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category” (Annexure IV) or “The Income and Assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category (Annexure V)

5.2. OTHER GENERAL RULES FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION

General rule for Conversion of Vacant Seats

5.2.1 The seats un-availed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidate and vice versa. If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates, the same will be notified in the media and a separate allotment for SC/ST candidates will be made by the University. However, even after this, if SC/ST seats are remaining vacant such seats shall be filled as detailed below.

Government/Self Financing/Aided Colleges except Colleges run by Backward Minority Communities:

The unfilled seats shall be filled up from the candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities (OEC) in the Annexure II(c) of the prospectus and in their absence, candidates belonging to SEBC. The seats that further remain unfilled will go to the General Merit Quota.

If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SEBC, the seats that remain unfilled will be converted to the General Merit Quota.

Aided Colleges run by Backward Minority Communities:

The unfilled seats shall be filled on the basis of the merit as per the rank list from among the applicants of **backward minority community**, which runs the college. If seats still remain unfilled, it will be filled up from candidates belonging to OEC and in their absence, candidates belonging to SEBC. The seats that further remain unfilled will go to the General Merit Quota.

6. RULES FOR ADMISSION OF STUDENTS TO VARIOUS PG DEGREE PROGRAMME IN AFFILIATED COLLEGES

6.1. Assessment of Merit: Except when otherwise provided, the merit of a candidate will be assessed on the basis of the grade points obtained by the candidate in the qualifying examinations for admission to the particular programme, subject to such criteria as may be prescribed by the University. In assessing merit, bonus score will be awarded for extra curricular activities like NCC, NSS. of the students. These bonus score will be added to the grade points obtained for the qualifying examination for preparing the rank list.

6.2 Weightage:

Bonus score in respect of N.C.C. and N.S.S. candidates will be given for the purpose of ranking in the manner given below:

In respect of NCC applicants, the bonus score of 0.1 will be awarded on the basis of NCC certificates signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC to the candidates who have secured at least 75% attendance after having participated in its activity during the course of study immediately preceding the course for which admission is sought.

An additional score of 0.05 and 0.1 will be awarded to NCC cadets holding B, C certificates respectively for the purpose of admission to PG course in affiliated colleges.

For awarding Bonus score of 0.1 to NSS participants, the basis will be NSS certificate signed by the Vice Chancellor and issued by the University to volunteers who have completed 240 hours of work within a period of two years in the course of study immediately preceding the course for which the admission sought.

The benefit of bonus score for purposes of admission can be earned by the candidates only under any one category (either N.S.S. or N.C.C).

Note : Weightage mark will be subject to the decision of the Syndicate.

A Grace Score of 10% of Initial Index Score shall be given to applicants to PG courses who have passed the qualifying examination, after undergoing the whole prescribed course of study from a college affiliated to the Kannur University.

A Grace Score of 20% of Initial Index Score to the ST applicants of Wayanad district for admission in Arts& Science colleges of Wayanad District under the Jurisdiction of Kannur University as per order No. Acad/D2/2805/2017 dated 20/04/2017.

6.2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

6.2.1 Notwithstanding anything contained in the Statutes, the selection of students in Government colleges shall be governed by the rules prescribed by the Government from time to time with the concurrence of the University in respect of such admissions.

2. Candidates should submit the printout of the application form to the colleges concerned.

6.4 Equivalency/Recognition

Candidates who passed their qualifying examination from the universities outside Kerala (recognized by University Grants Commission) after regular study needn't produce equivalency certificate provided that there is no difference in nomenclature. Students who passed their degrees through distance education from universities outside Kerala(except the Degrees from

IGNOU that do not require hands on training and those who obtained regular degrees with different nomenclature from universities in or outside Kerala should submit Equivalency Certificate(*stating that the said degree of other University is equated to concerned degree of Kannur University*) while seeking admission. If the eligibility is 'any degree' recognition certificate is sufficient

6.5 Deduction/Loosing of grade points for subsequent appearances

Candidates will lose a score of 0.1for ranking purpose for every successive attempt after the first attempt of qualifying examination, subject to a maximum of a score of 0.25. The numbers of chances means the number of chances taken for passing any part of the qualifying examination. Betterment of examination will not be considered as a chance.

6.6 Resolving of tie:

In the case of a tie of index score, the following will be considered on a priority basis

- Grade points of the subject opted
- Grade points of the complementary I
- Grade points of the complementary II
- Grade points of Common course I (First Language English)
- Grade points of Common course II (Second Language)

7 Fee to be paid to the University

7.1 Fee to be paid to the University for Registration

The Registration Fee is ₹500/- (For SC/ST /PWBD candidates – ₹300 /-)

Note: The fee has to be remitted by online (SBIPay) payment only.

7.2 Fee to be paid to the University on allotment

On securing admission, the under mentioned University fee has to be remitted by **SBIPay** only. **The printout of the payment of transaction should be produced in the college at the time of admission.**

The following steps shall be adopted for the computation of index scores and ranking for the admission to P.G. Programmes.

Step 1:-[Computation of Initial Index Score for M.Sc. &M.Com and M.A. Programmes excluding languages]:

Calculate the Initial Index Score by the formula,

$$\text{Initial Index Score} = \frac{(\text{Total C.G.P. of Core and Complementary}) + (\text{C.G.P of Core alone})}{(\text{Credit of Core and Complementary}) + (\text{Credit of Core alone})}$$

Example:

Course	Credit	OGPA	CGP = Credit x OGPA
Core	56	9.711	543.816
Complementary I	12	9.700	116.400
Complementary II	12	9.000	108.000
Total	80		768.216

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Initial Index Score} &= \frac{768.216 + 543.816}{80+56} \\ &= \frac{1312.032}{136} \\ &= 9.647 \end{aligned}$$

Note: As the students of U G Programmes for/from the year 2014 admission (CBCSS) have been evaluated on the basis of 10 point scale, the Initial Index Score also is a figure out of 10.

For the students who have undergone their U G Programme based on CCSS (2009 admission to 2013 admission), Grading System (2008 Admission) and mark system (up to 2007 admission), calculate the Initial Index Score as explained and illustrated in the guidelines as per Ref. No. 1. As this Initial Index Score is out of 4, convert it to 10 by multiplying by 2.5.

Example: In case of a student under CCSS 2013 admission,

Initial Index Score = 3.835 (out of 4)

Then convert it to $3.835 \times 2.5 = 9.588$ (out of 10)

- If a candidate completed BSc programme in Mathematics wants to apply for admission for **MSc Statistics Programme**. In this case, the initial index score is to be calculated as follows:

$$\text{Initial Index Score} = \frac{(\text{Total C.G.P. of Core and Complimentary}) + (\text{C.G.P of Statistics})}{(\text{Credit of Core and Complimentary} + \text{Credit of Statistics})}$$

[Computation of Initial Index Score for M.Sc. Statistics with Data Analytics Programme.]

The index score for preparing the rank list shall be calculated on the basis of the marks/grade points of Main (Core Courses) and Subsidiaries (Complimentary courses) scored by the candidates in the B.Sc Degree programme. 50% of the total seats in each category shall be reserved for the B.Sc degree holders in Statistics single main or Statistics and Mathematics double main if there are claimants. For B.Tech/B.E candidates index score is calculated on the basis of total marks/grade points of the B.Tech/B.E programme and marks/grade points scored in Mathematics courses of the programme.

- **[Computation of Initial Index Score for Languages]**

(i) For M.A. English Programme:

Initial Index Score is the maximum of C.G.P. of Common Course-I and Total C.G.P. of Core and Complimentary

Credit of Core and Complimentary

(ii) For M.A. Non-English Programme:

Initial Index Score is the maximum of C.G.P. of Common Course-II and Total C.G.P. of Core and Complimentary

Credit of Core and Complimentary

For PG Degree Programme under Faculty of Languages & Literature, 10% of Initial Index Score calculated as mentioned above will be added to the Initial Index Score as Bonus for the candidates who have studied the subject as Core. (5% of Functional English and Functional Hindi). Comparing this with CGP of Common Course, the maximum of the two is taken as Initial Index Score.

Step 2: [Computation of Second Index Score]

The Second Index Score shall be computed by adding the grace scores (G) to the Initial Index Score. The students who have done their qualifying U.G degree from Kannur University are eligible for a Grace Score of 10% of Initial Index Score, as per Ref. No.2 cited. In the case of other students, the grace score is Zero. That is, the Second Index Score is same as the Initial Index Score.

Example: If the student mentioned in the illustration above has done the qualifying degree from Kannur University, then the Second Index Score is,

$$9.647 + [9.647 \times 10/100] = 9.647 + 0.965 \\ = 10.612$$

Step 3: [Computation of Third Index Score]

The Third Index Score shall be computed by adding the 'bonus score' (B) to the Second Index Score. NCC and NSS candidates are eligible for bonus score. The bonus score for NSS and NCC is 0.1. NCC 'B' Certificate and 'C' Certificate holders are eligible for an additional score of 0.05 and 0.1 respectively, i.e., (The bonus score for NCC 'B' & 'C' Certificate holders will be 0.15 & 0.2 respectively). These scores are to be added to the second Index Score in the case of NCC and NSS candidates. [As the Initial Index Score of students under CCSS (2009 to 2013), grading (2008) and mark (up to 2007) are being converted to 10 point scale in step 1, the bonus scores are the same to all as explained above]. In the case of other students, the bonus score is Zero. That is, Third Index Score is same as Second Index Score.

Example: If the student explained in the illustration is eligible for a bonus score 0.1 on account of NCC/NSS, then the Third Index Score = 10.612 + 0.1 = 10.712

Step 4: [Computation of Final Index Score]

The Final Index Score shall be obtained by subtracting a 'Handicap Score' (H) of 0.1, 0.2 and 0.25 from the Third Index Score of those students who have taken two chances, three chances and more than three chances respectively for completing their qualifying U G degree. The 'number of chances' means the number of chances taken for passing any part of the qualifying examination. Betterment of qualified results (Improvement) will not be considered as a chance. In the case the students who have taken only one chance for passing the qualifying examination, the handicap score is Zero. That is, the Final Index Score is same as the Third Index Score.

The Final Index Score shall be rounded to three decimal places.

Example: If the student explained in the illustration has taken two chances for completing the qualifying U.G. degree examination, then the Final Index Score = 10.712 – 0.1 = 10.612

10. Post Allotment Activities:

Reporting at the College: The candidates who get allotment will have to report before the Principal/Head of the College/Institution concerned for admission on the dates notified, with the following documents:

- a) Print out of completed online application generated by the Candidate.
- b) Print out of Registration Fee & University Fee remitted by the candidate by online.
- c) Original grade cards/marklists and Provisional/Degree Certificate of the qualifying examination.
- d) Certificate to prove date of birth
- e) TC from the Institution last attended
- f) Course & Conduct Certificate
- g) **Original Community Certificate /Caste Certificate /Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category certificate (EWS) /The Income and Assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)if applicable**

h) Non creamy layer certificate in the case of SEBC candidates.

- i) Original certificates to prove the claim for grace marks, if any.
- j) Equivalency certificate (stating that the said degree of other University is equated to concerned degree of Kannur University) from Kannur University in the case of candidates who passed qualifying examination through Distance Education from Universities outside Kerala (**except Degrees from IGNOU that do not require hands on training**) and those who obtained degrees with different nomenclature. (Recognition Certificate is sufficient if the eligibility is 'any UG degree'). The college can refer any doubtful cases of equivalency/ recognition to the university.
- k) Any other relevant certificate for any claim made in the application.

11. Verification of Documents: The Principal/Head of the Institution shall be personally responsible for verification and satisfaction of the correctness of the documents/records produced by the candidate, at the time of seeking admission in the College/Institution. The candidates should fulfil the eligibility criteria prescribed at the time of online registration, in all respects, and all relevant documents shall be submitted at the respective colleges during the time of admission. The eligibility of the candidates for the course in all respects shall be confirmed by the Principal before the closure of admission.

The Principal should ensure identification of candidates during Admission and verify their photographs uploaded at the time of registration.

12.SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Failure to report for Admission: Candidates who do not take admission on the prescribed date will lose their admission.
2. Candidates have the freedom to change their password. However they should take note of the password and application number carefully, for future login.
3. Application of candidates, who do not register their personal and academic data online and who do not give their options online, within the time schedule, will not be considered for allotment. No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details after the last date of submission of application.
Late or defective application will not be considered, under any circumstances.
4. Any kind of false information will lead to cancellation of admission.
5. No rounding of marks / percentage to the nearest whole number will be permitted.
6. Those who are awaiting results of the last semester/year, but passed in all the previous semesters /year can also apply. However, they should be qualified on or before the last date of submission of the application.
7. **Do not send hardcopies of the printout of the online application to the university. The hardcopy of the online application with supporting documents should be submitted by the candidate at the time of admission to the college.**
8. Any other item which is not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the University and that decision shall be final.
9. **Preventive measure against ragging** : if an applicant for admission is found to have been indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that the candidate had indulged in ragging, admission shall be revoked or the candidate shall be expelled from the educational institution. Candidate & Parents should submit the undertaking (see ANNEXURE III) to the College , before getting admission to the college.

10. Declaration against Dowry: Each and every student of the institution and their parents, or guardian are required to submit a combined undertaking at the time of admission in prescribed format available in Annexure VI which is mandatory for admission against dowry.

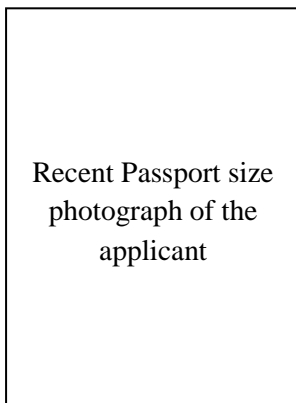

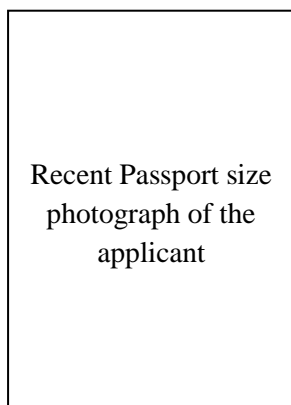
