## Student Satisfaction Survey Report 2023-24

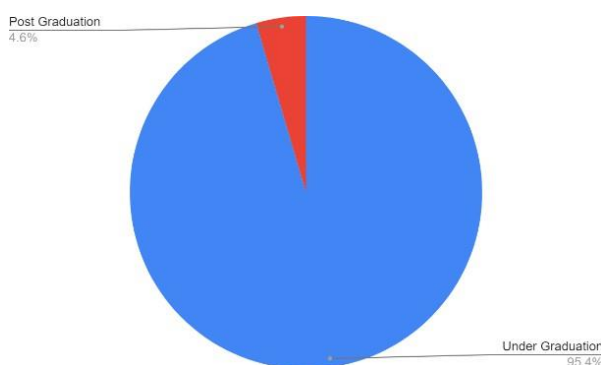

The responses collected from students through google form were fed to an excel sheet designed for the analysis. The question-wise outcome of the results is presented below:

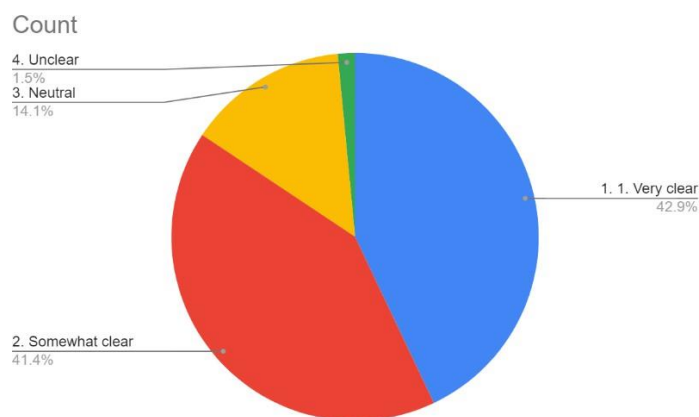
Which degree program are you pursuing now?

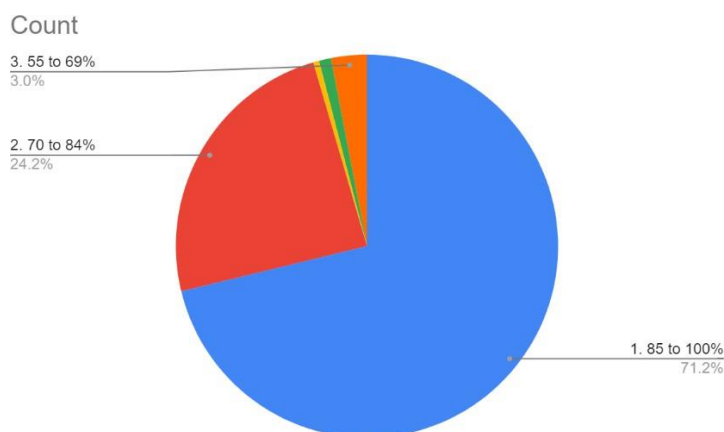
1. How clear are the course objective?

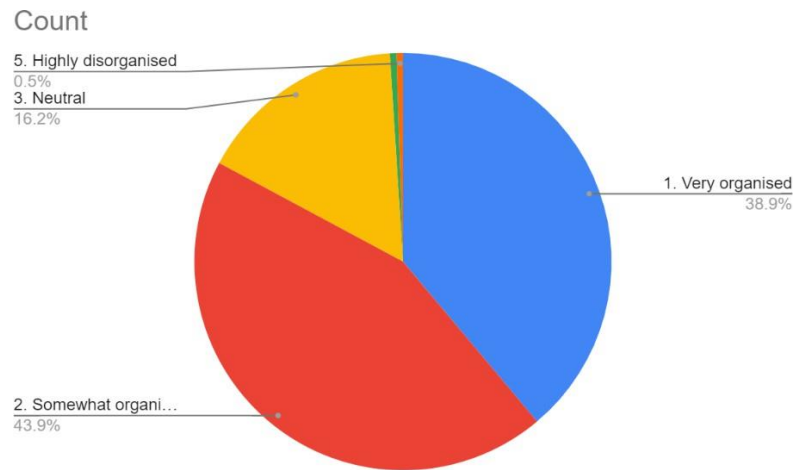
2. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

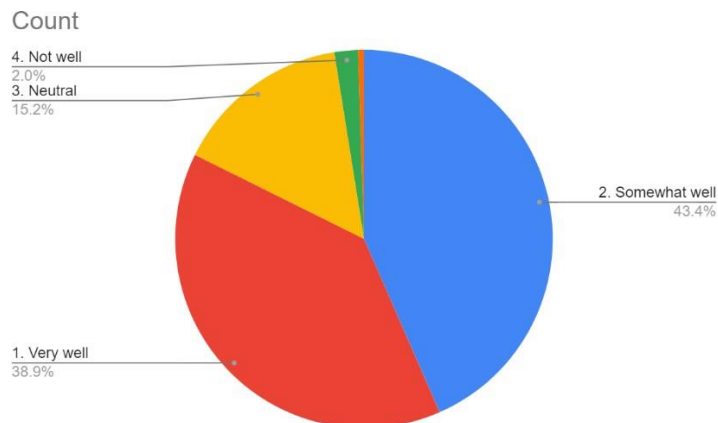
3. How organized was the course in terms of the time frame and assessment and access to materials?

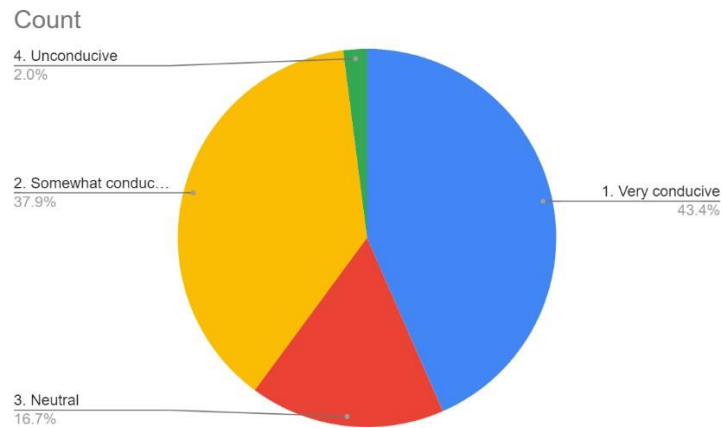
4. How well did the course achieve the stated learning outcomes?

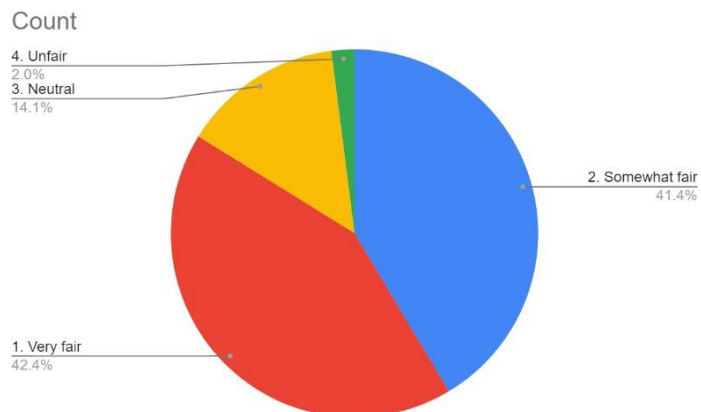
5. How conducive was the learning environment?

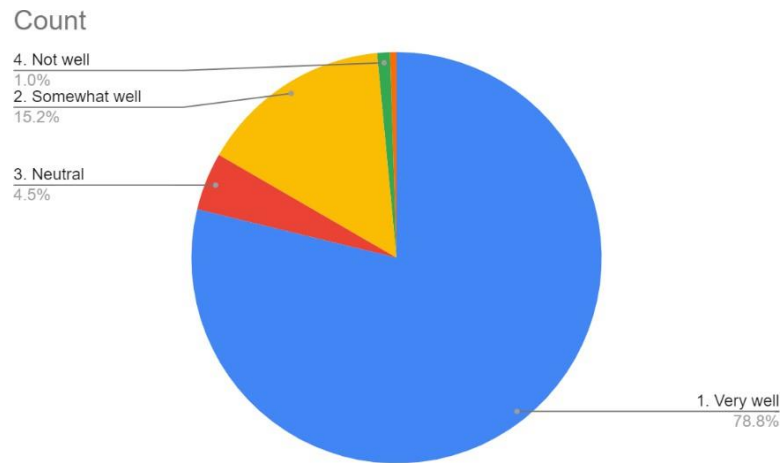
6. How fair was the course assessment method?

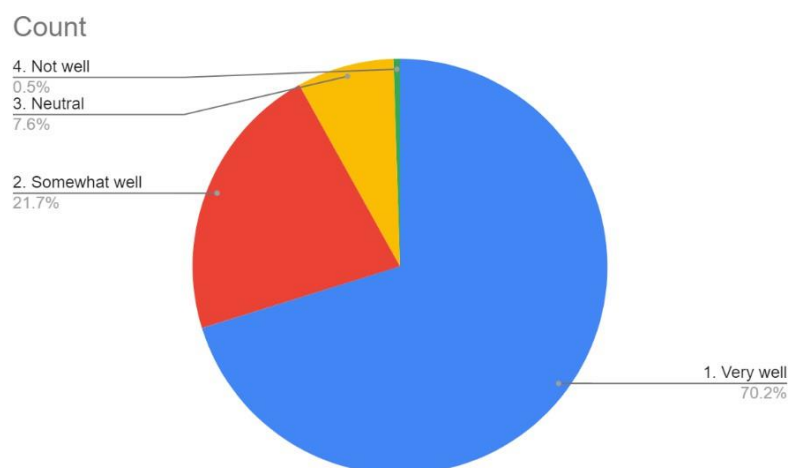
7. How well did the teacher respond to students' inquiries?

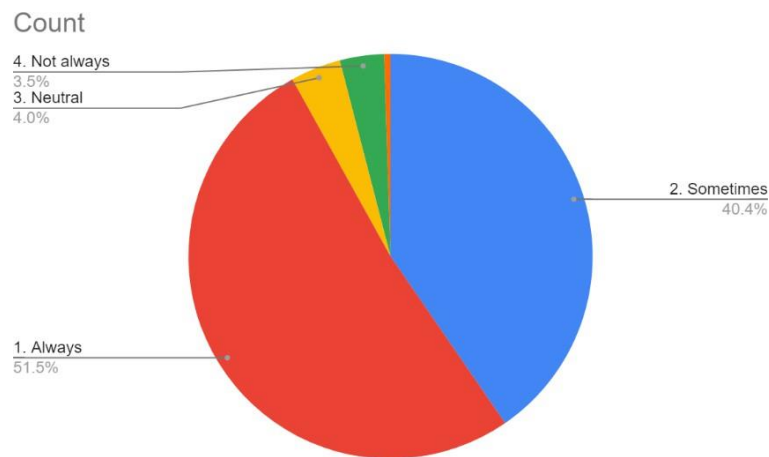
8. How well does the teacher communicate the subjects to the students?

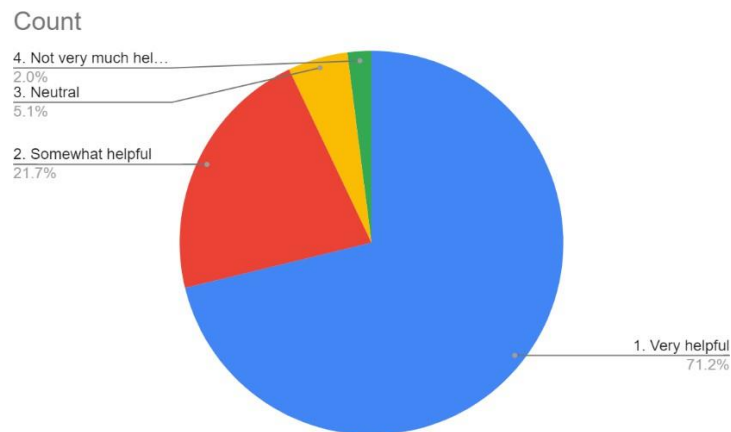
9. Did the teacher encourage feedback from the students?

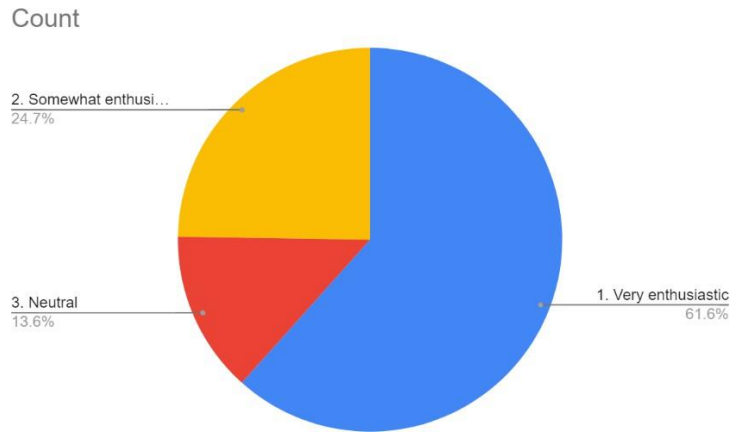
10. How helpful is the teacher in responding to the students' needs?

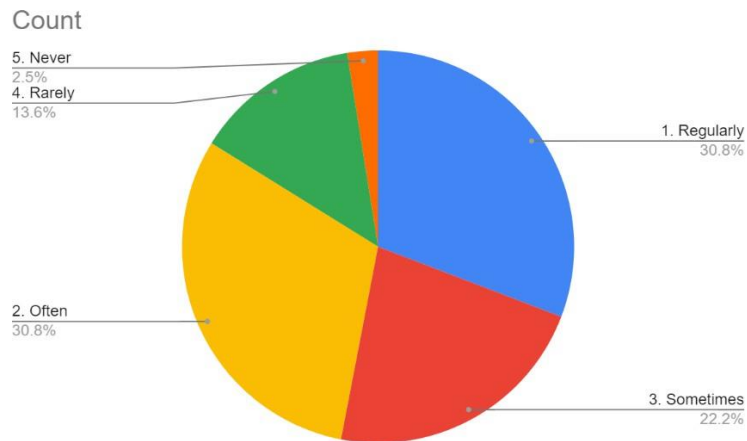
11. How enthusiastic and friendly was the teacher about the subject?

12. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

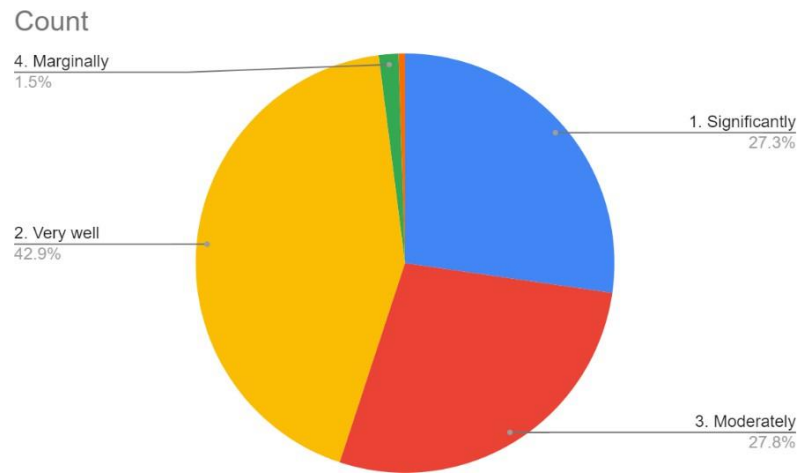

13. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

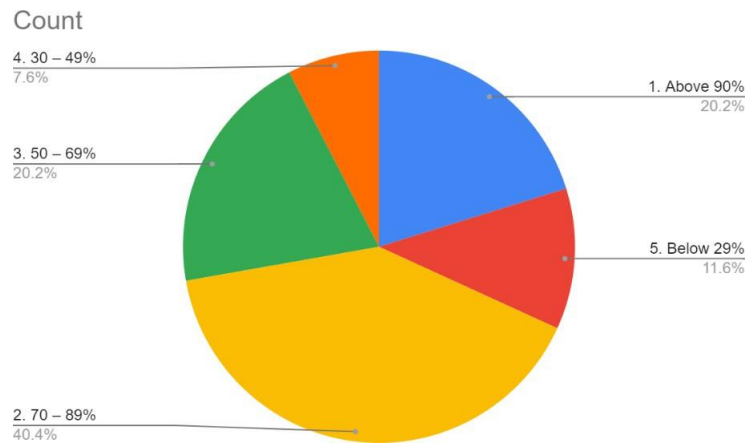

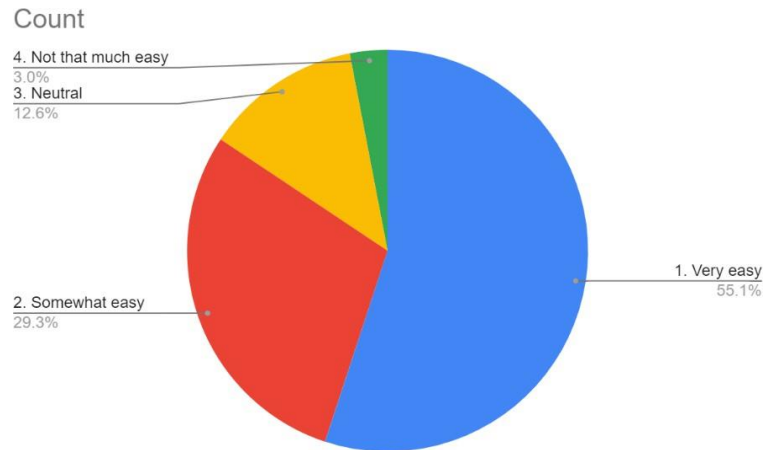
14. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

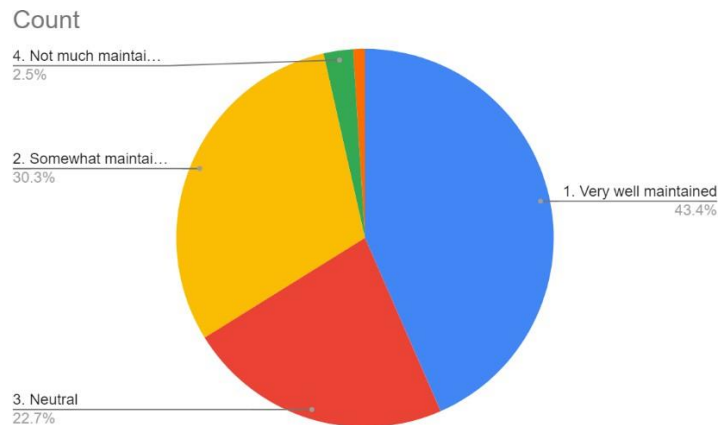
15. How easy it is to get the resources you need from the college library?

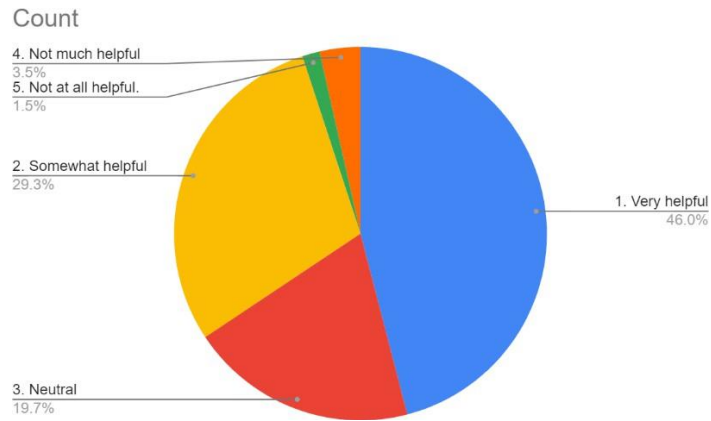
16. How well-maintained are the facilities?

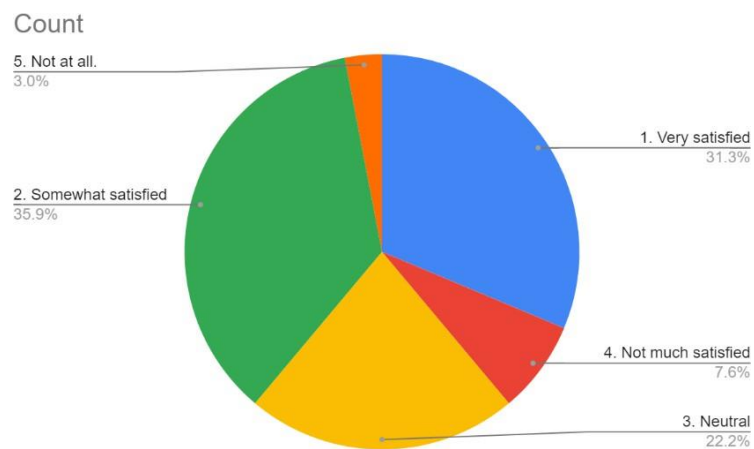
17. How helpful are the campus staff with administrative and other issues?

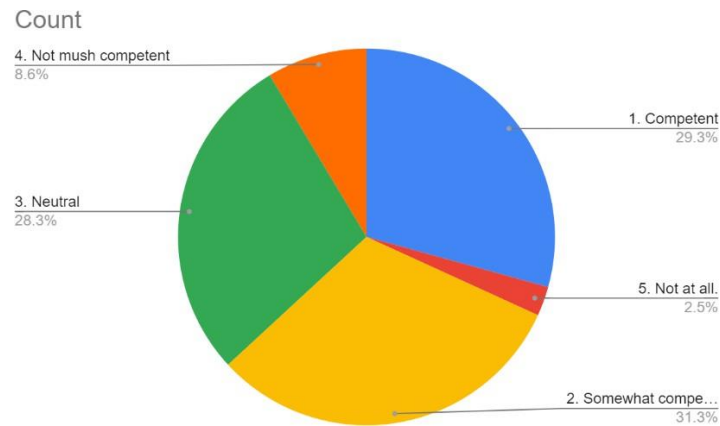
18. How satisfied are you with the diversity and quality of the offered extracurricular activities?

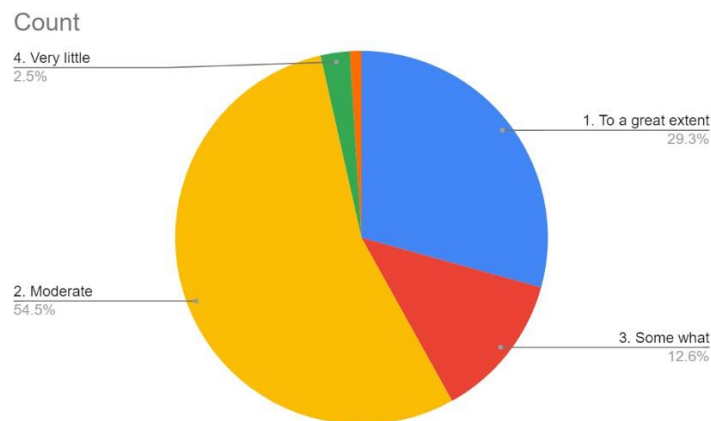
19. Do you feel job-competent moving forward from this college?

**Key Findings from the Survey:**

1. Students have expressed overall satisfaction regarding the syllabus completion), teacher's response to their inquiries and communications with the students regarding the subjects.
2. Teacher's preparation, communication, use of appropriate teaching pedagogy and fairness of internal evaluation has been rated fair in the survey.
3. The college offers opportunities for cultural activities, sports activities and extra curricular activities.
4. The students have opined that college also provides good environment for their social and emotional growth.

5. The students opined that the learning environment provided by our college is conducive.

The SSS has also pointed out few grey areas where the college/ teachers/ departments do have scope for enhancement in quality of education. They are as follows:

1. Institute needs to promote field visit opportunities.
2. Enhance use of ICT in teaching.
3. Active mentorship especially for job competence.
