

- 1. IQAC, SES College, Sreekandapuram has organised an Induction Programme for Staff on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2023. 24 faculty members from SES College participated in it.
- 2. IQAC, SES College, Sreekandapuram conducted a Training session on PO, PSO, CO evaluation on 7<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 and 33 faculty members attended it.

### **PTA**
