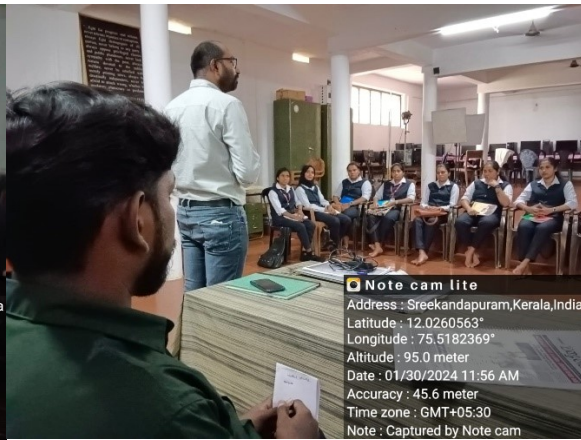
Adding a Human Touch to Journalism
