On the 24th of August, 2023, the Forum for Democratic Student Justice (FDSJ) at SES College, Sreekandapuram, submitted a request to the Principal, Dr. Dominic Thomas, to play the national anthem every evening at 3:30 PM through the college audio system. Details of the Request
