

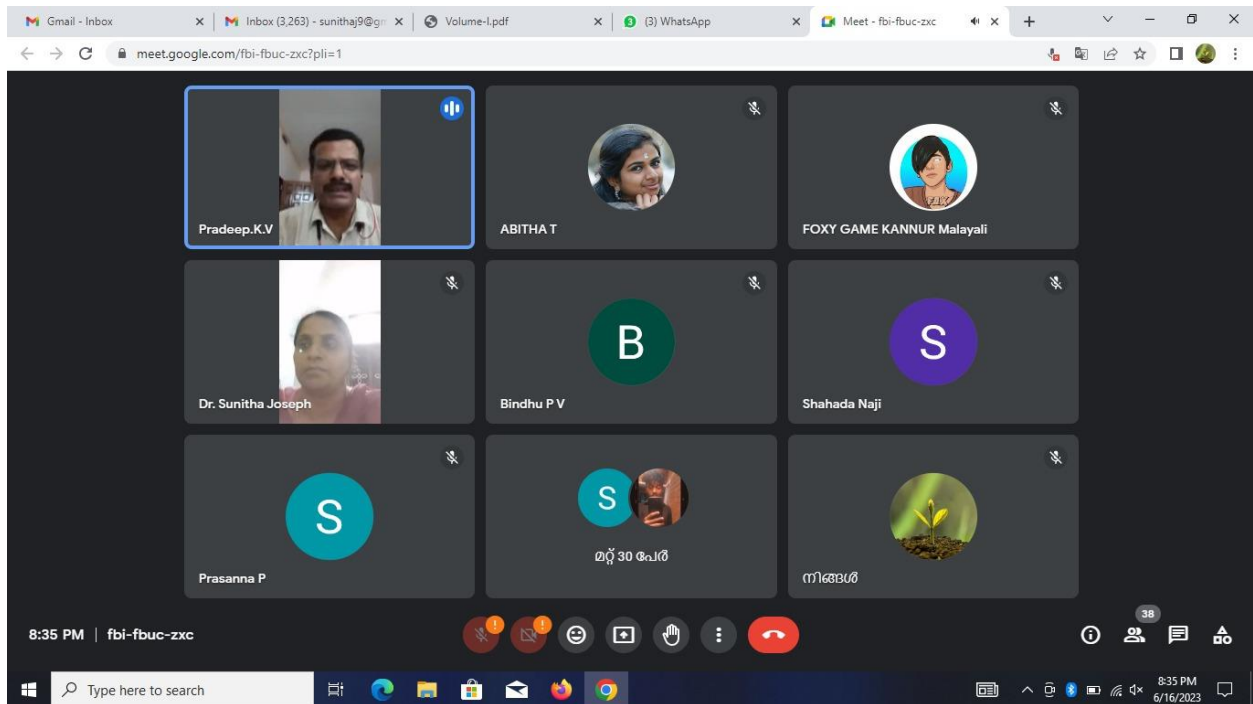

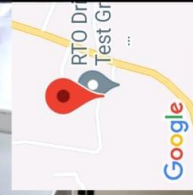

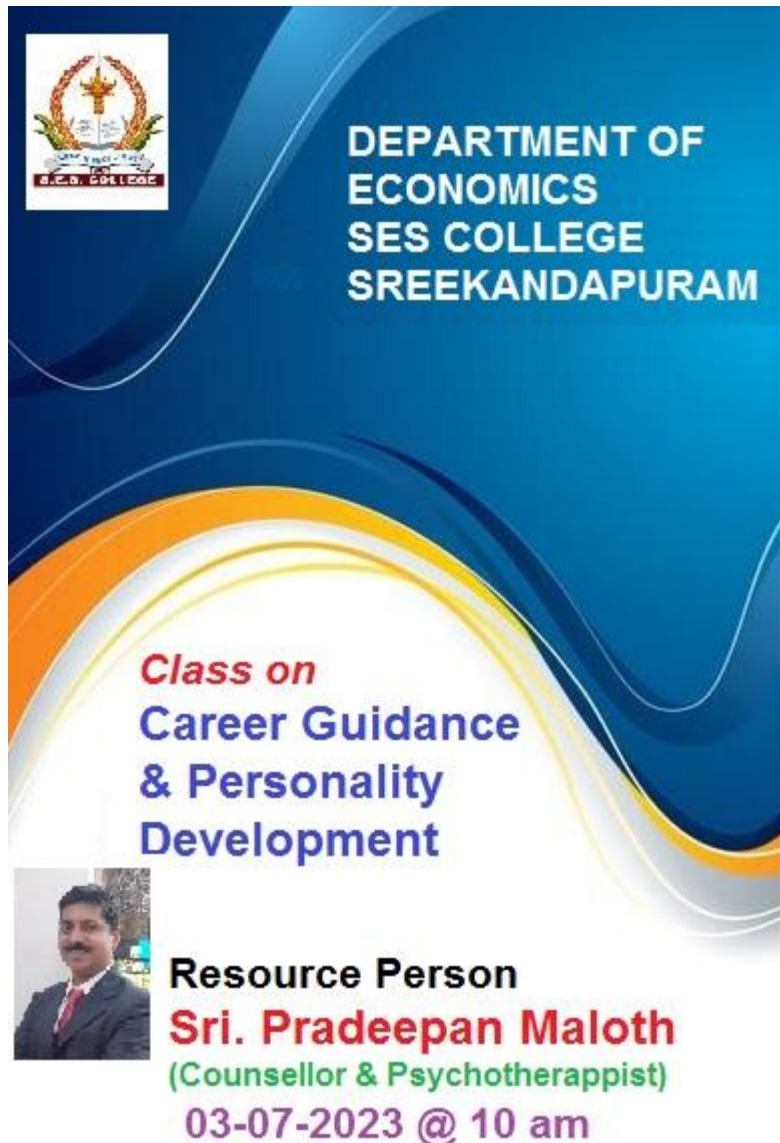
VISIT TO ECOLOGICAL SITE

TRAINING FOR COMPETITIVE EXAM – 30

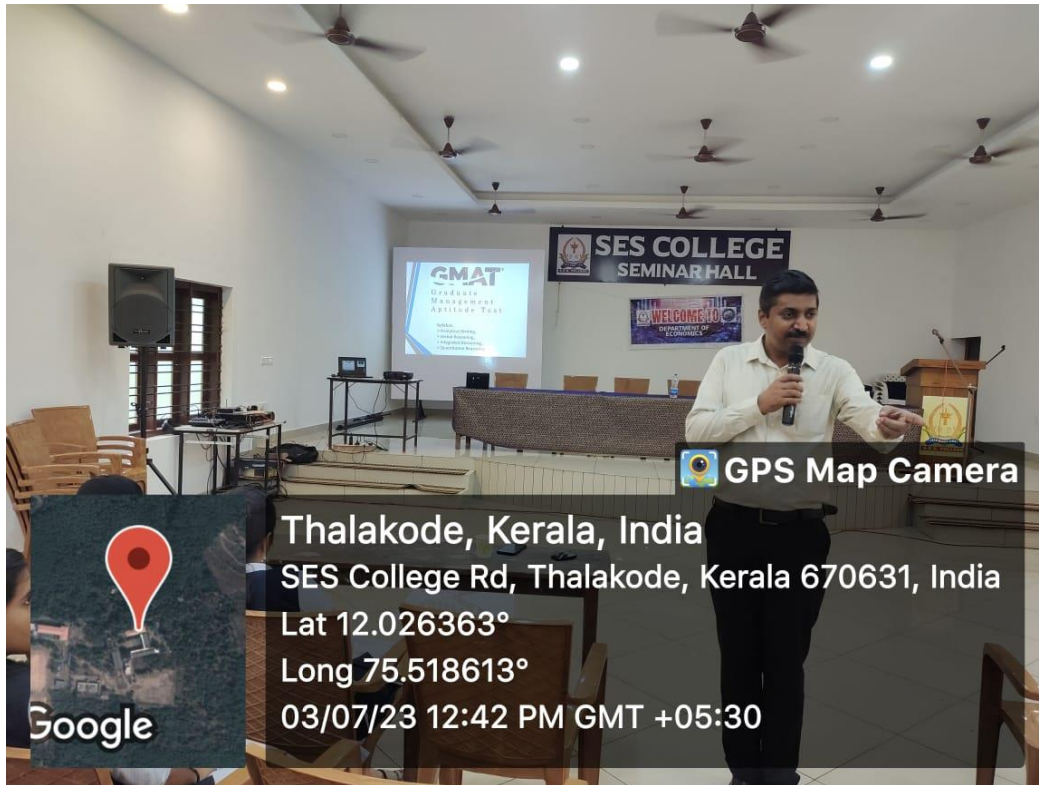

Identify a suitable Anganwadi center in the vicinity of your college or community. The visit was on 4-8-2023 and 12 students actively participated in the programme. We contacted the center in advance to discuss the possibility of a visit and to understand their schedule and requirements. Conducted an orientation session for the participating students to familiarize them with the concept and objectives of Anganwadi centers, as well as the services they provide to children and mothers in the community. Planned a range of interactive and age-appropriate activities for the students to engage with the children at the Anganwadi. These could include storytelling, art and craft, games, music and dance, educational activities, and health and hygiene awareness sessions. After the visit, facilitate a briefing session for the students to reflect on their experiences, insights, and the impact of their interactions with the children at the Anganwadi. By organizing an Anganwadi visit as part of a kids care program, students can gain valuable insights into the needs and challenges faced by children in their community, while also making a positive impact through their interactions and support.

PLASTIC WASTE CLEANING

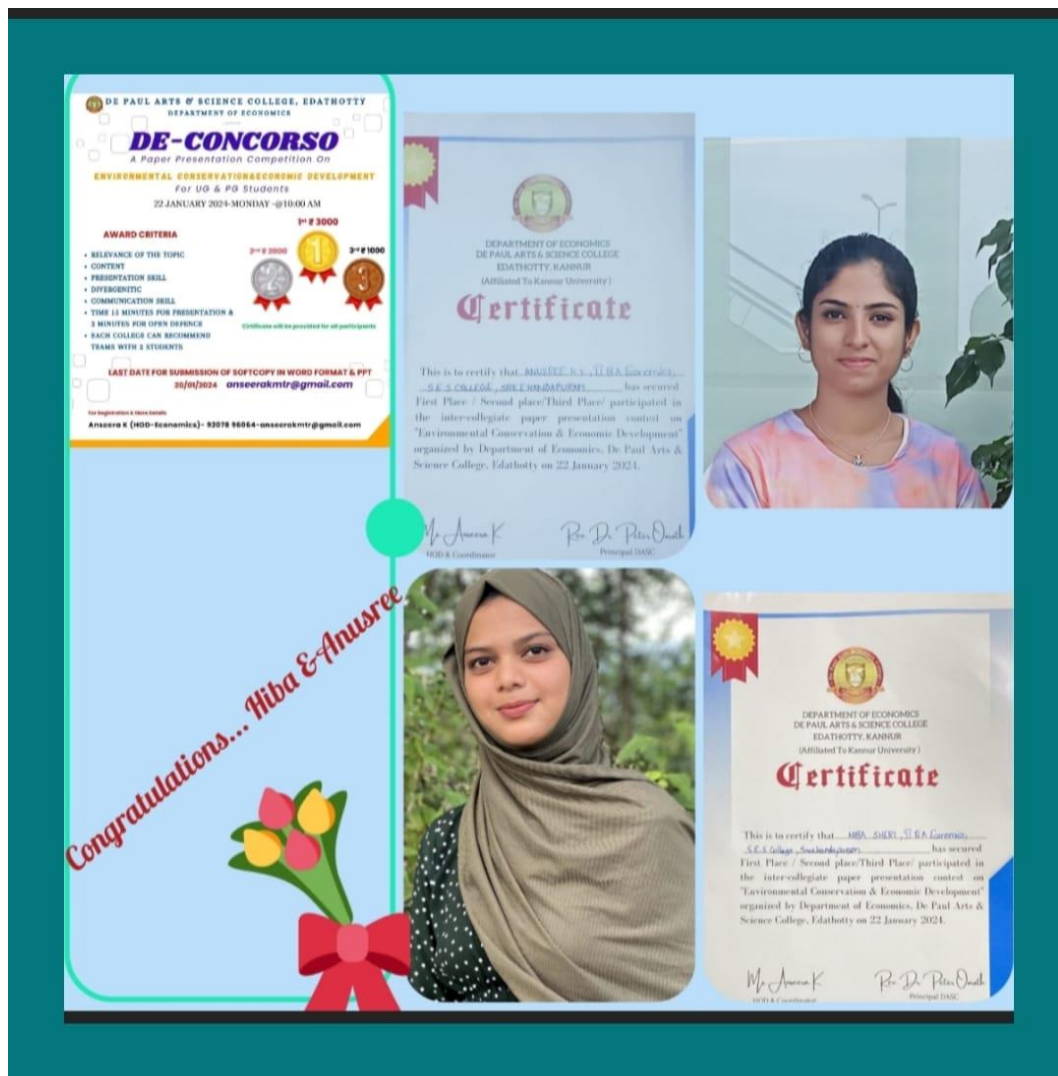

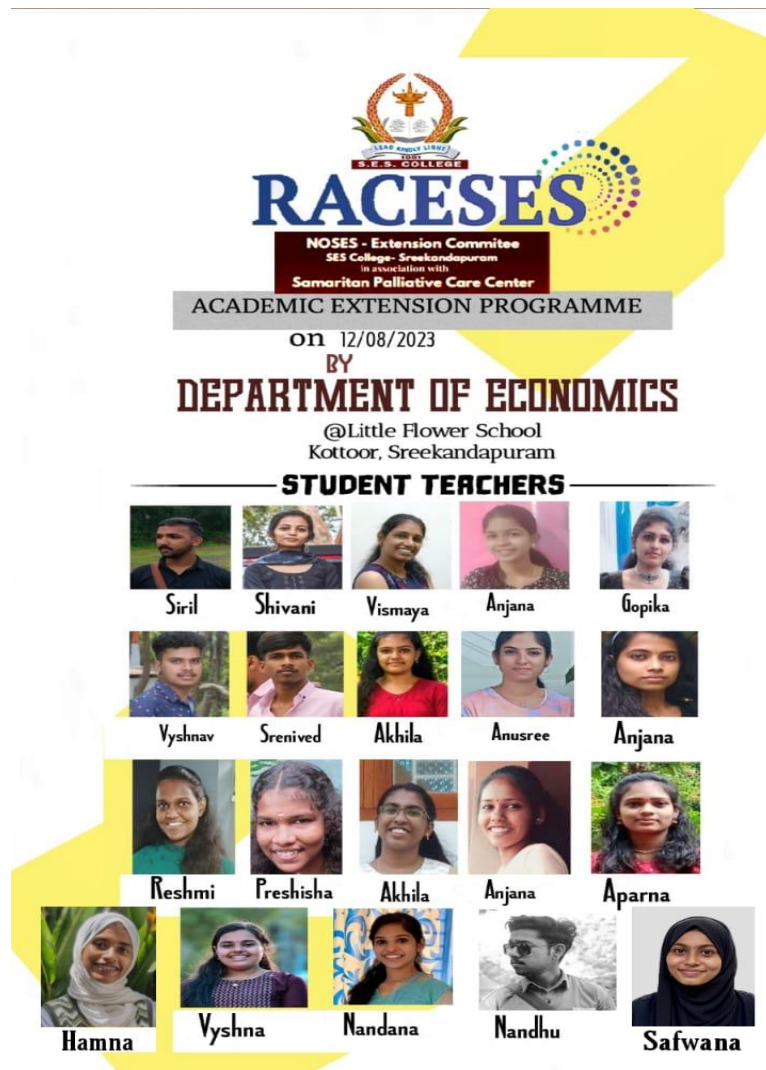
PARTICIPATION IN CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

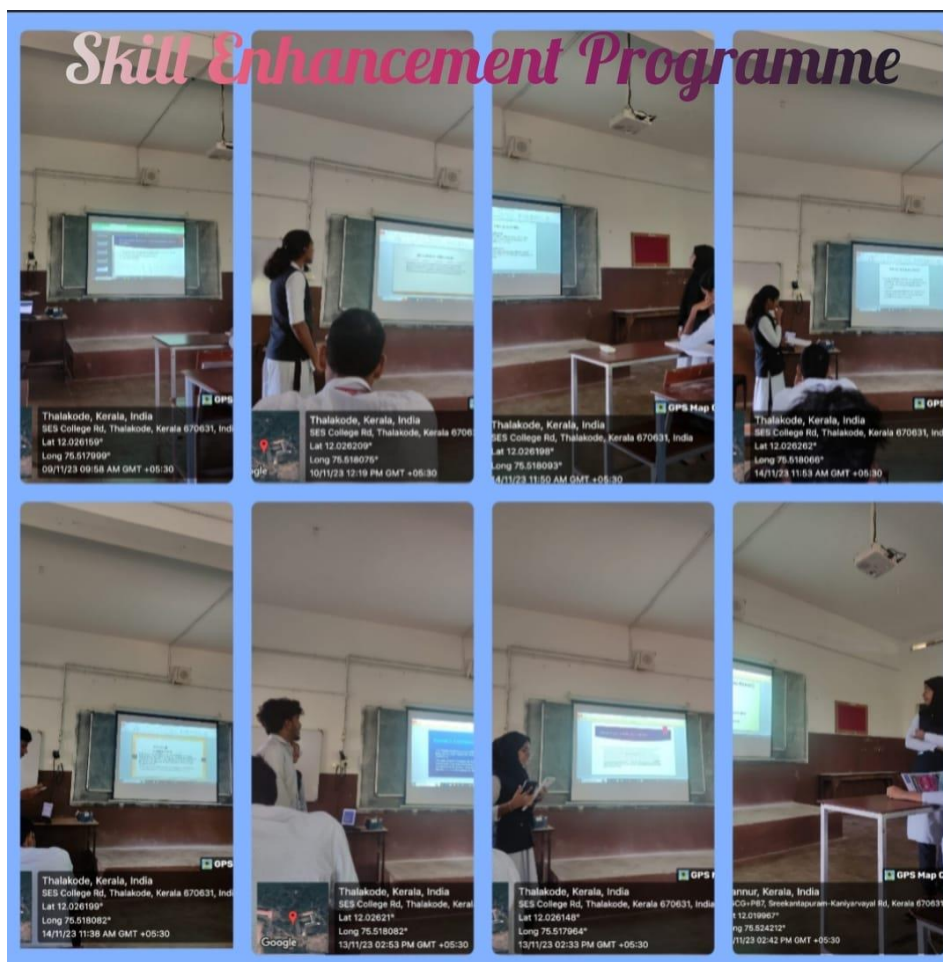
