










STUDY ABROAD ORIENTATION CLASS

Language and communication skill development seminar was conducted on 23rd January. Students from various departments benefitted the same. Sneha P P, Professional Social worker and trainer handled the session.








12. KARIERO NAFASI: Career Guidance Programme











CAREER GUIDANCE CLASS



PENCIL DRAWING COMPETITION






CHANDRAYAN -3 LANDING - 23/08/2023








2023-24 MERITO DIEM ANNUAL REPORT












STUDY ABROAD ORIENTATION CLASS

Language and communication skill development seminar was conducted on 23rd January. Students from various departments benefitted the same. Sneha P P, Professional Social worker and trainer handled the session.








CAREER GUIDANCE CLASS



PENCIL DRAWING COMPETITION






CHANDRAYAN -3 LANDING - 23/08/2023

Water Announcement Initiative by FDSJ Wing

SREEKANDAPURAM

Amidst the scorching summer and increased concerns of dehydration among students, the FDSJ wing of SES College, Sreekandapuram, initiated a pioneering step to promote hydration. Inspired by the Kerala government's 'Water Bell' campaign for schools, this initiative marks the first of its kind in Kerala's higher education institutions, despite the absence of a direct mandate from the government.

The Kerala government's 'Water Bell' initiative was introduced to combat dehydration among school students during the peak summer months. Recognizing the effectiveness of this program, the FDSJ wing at SES College decided to implement a similar strategy to ensure their college students stay hydrated.

Implementation

Concept Development

Lijitha M., a second-year MAJMC student, played a crucial role in creating the script, announcement and editing of the program. The core concept of the program was developed under the guidance of FDSJ staff coordinator Previn P. F.

Content of Announcement

A 19-second audio message was crafted to remind students to drink water and inform them about the potential consequences of dehydration.

Broadcast Details

Start Date: The initiative commenced on March 3rd.

Duration: Announcements were made until March 26th, the start of the summer vacation.

Frequency: The audio messages were broadcast through the audio announcement systems installed on every floor of the college at 11.20 a.m.

Outcome

The announcement aimed to encourage regular water intake among students, emphasizing the importance of hydration for health and well-being. The initiative was well-received by the college community. Students appreciated the reminders, and many reported an increase in their daily water intake as a result. Faculty members also supported the initiative, recognizing its importance in maintaining student health during the hot summer months.

Impact

The water announcement initiative by the FDSJ wing at SES College, Sreekandapuram, gained significant media attention, further amplifying its impact. Radio Mango, a popular radio station, featured the program on their show "JOSH JUNCTION." During the broadcast, RJ Ramesh played the 19-second




Screen Shots of Water announcement






