The Department of History has organized an Academic Extension Activity on January 10, 2025, screening of a historical documentary, "WITNESS: A JOURNEY THROUGH THE HISTORY OF KANNUR." 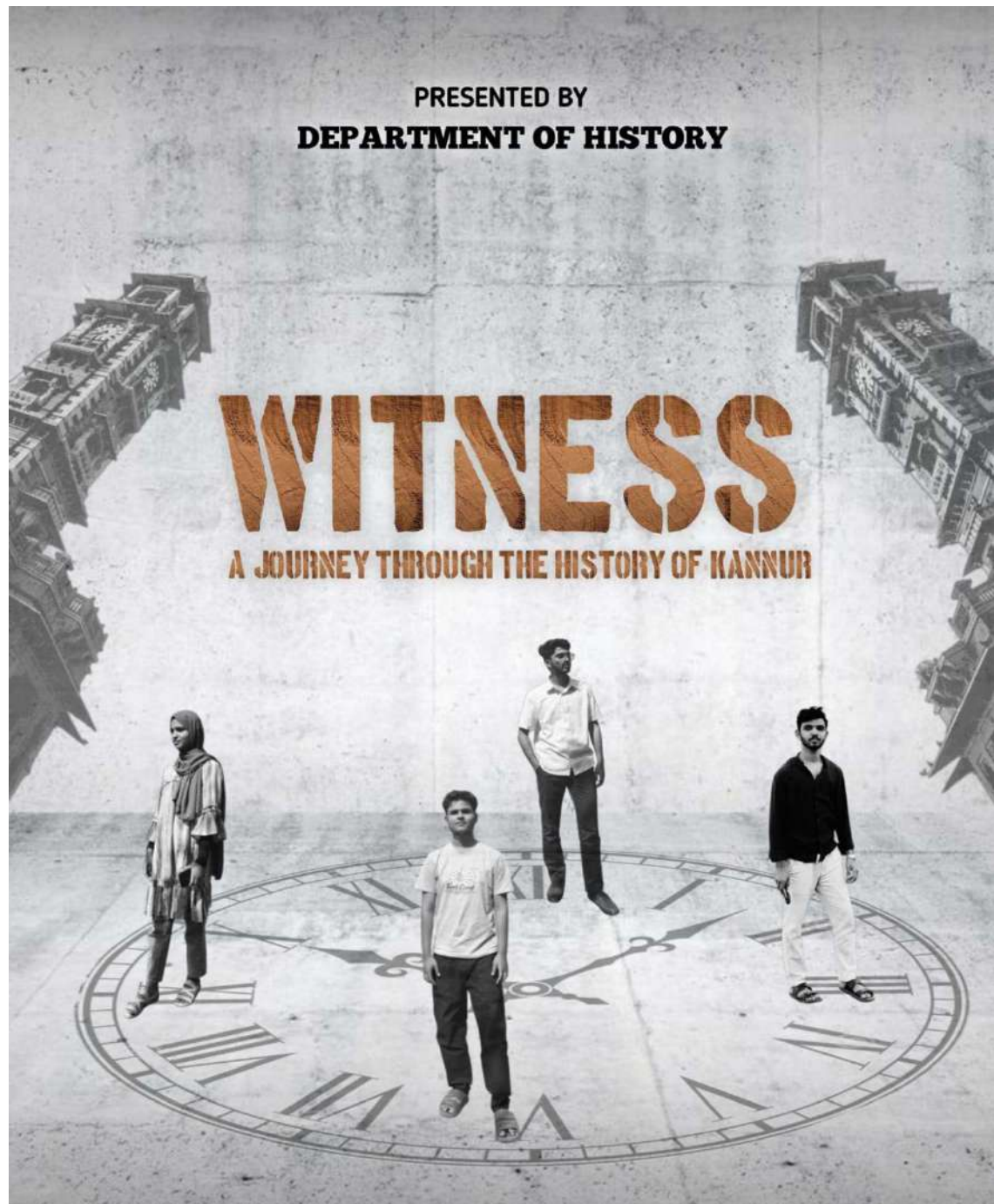
Objectives of the Programme
